## **Classified Position Description**

Job Title: Swimming Pool Caretaker

**Basic Function:** Under the supervision of the area supervisor, maintains and operates swimming pool equipment and facilities and provides custodial care of pool premises.

**Provides work or lead direction to:** Not applicable.

## **Representative Duties:**

- 1. Performs a variety of work in the maintenance and operation of a swimming pool.
- 2. Checks and operates filters and pumps to fill and clean the pool.
- 3. Maintains pool, including proper chemical and PH rate for the purpose of complying with mandated safety and health requirements.
- 4. Maintain and program electronic controller with chemical sensing probes. Must be able to adjust feed rate manually in case of controller failure.
- 5. Maintains cleanliness in and around the pool, which includes brushing and vacuuming the pool, washing deck and walkway, cleaning tile and cleaning for algae.
- 6. Inspects, lubricates, and makes minor repairs of pumps, equipment, and machinery used in the operation of the pool.
- 7. Performs custodial care of pool facilities (e.g., locker rooms, restrooms, mechanical rooms, offices, trash disposal).
- 8. Assists in grounds maintenance when pool duties are complete.
- 9. Monitors inventory levels of chemicals and other pool maintenance supplies. Orders parts and supplies as needed.
- 10. Maintains records for the purpose of providing an up-to-date reference trail and/or complying with mandated requirements.
- 11. Participates in District-provided in-service training programs.
- 12. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty, and the public.
- 13. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.

**Education:** Graduation from high school or GED equivalent.

**Experience:** One year of general experience in the operation and maintenance of mechanical devises including some experience with swimming pool equipment is preferred. Mechanical aptitude.

**Licenses/ Certifications Required:** Must have a valid California driver license and have (and maintain) an insurable diving record acceptable to the District's insurance carrier.

**Knowledge of:** Basic tools, methods, and procedures used in maintaining water pumps and purification equipment.

**Ability to:** Operate pool equipment; keep simple records; understand and carry out oral and written instructions; Responds to inquiries from students, staff, public, County Health Department, etc. for the purpose of conveying information regarding swimming pool operations, etc.

**Other:** Candidate must demonstrate clear evidence of sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability and ethnic backgrounds of community college students, staff and the community.

**Physical Effort:** Requires the ability to exert some physical effort, such as walking, standing and light lifting; dexterity in the use of fingers, limbs and body. Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.
