

BP 1432 CHANCELLOR SUCCESSION

Education Code Sections 70902(d) and 72400;
Title 5 Section 53021(b)

The Board of Trustees delegates authority to the Chancellor to appoint an Acting Chancellor to serve in the Chancellor's absence for short periods of time, not to exceed thirty (30) calendar days at a time.

The Board of Trustees shall appoint an Acting Chancellor for periods exceeding thirty (30) calendar days.

In the absence of the Chancellor and when an Acting Chancellor has not been named, administrative responsibility may be designated to one of the following positions:

- Vice Chancellor, Educational Services and Strategic Planning
- Vice Chancellor, Business and Financial Services
- Any College President
