Approval of minutes – July 14, 2011

Committee voted to approve the minutes. (M/Barnhart, S/Hix)

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Dr. Azari discussed current projects under construction: School of Nursing and Science & Math Complex. She responded to a question regarding the "poison garden," discussing examples of common household (toxic) plants as part of the student/community education process. She updated the committee on progress at Wheelock Gym, anticipated to be opening in mid-March 2012.

COLLEGE REPORT

Mr. Bogle introduced Ms. Stover who discussed her firm's annual Measure C audit results. Several committee members voiced questions: Member Barnhardt asked about the scope of the audit and the types and quantity of items audited. Member Barnhardt asked for clarification of select auditing terms. Mr. Brown discussed salaries that are charged against Measure C; i.e., facilities and planning managers whose direct workload is Measure C construction. Member Krause

requested more information about D series accrued interest and Build America Bonds. Action item: Mr. Brown will research whether it is a net number. Mr. Barnhardt discussed a contractor claim related to the Quad renovation/modernization. Action item: Member Taylor requested that the committee be given information about any legal expenses related to litigation in conjunction with Measure C projects.

Ms. Carlson provided an overview of prior Board of Trustees' discussion related to the purchase of parking spaces in a downtown Riverside parking structure. The parking agreement--generating 280 spaces--is in support of the RCCD Downtown Renaissance Block. The agreement with the city of Riverside resulted in an estimated savings of \$4.2 million compared to RCCD building additional subterranean or surface parking at the project site. The agreement is flexible in that it allows the District to sell unused spaces back to the city or to negotiate for additional spaces if needed in the future.

Mr. Brown distributed the Measure C Financial Summary Report, listing commitments through September 30, 2011, including potential energy use rebates related to the Riverside Aquatics Complex.

Mr. Doering and Mr. Stephens distributed the comprehensive construction program schedule and the Program Executive Summary. Specific items of discussion included a possible rescoping of the MVC Learning Gateway project, and Measure C projects that had been moved to the next funding cycle by the State Chancellor's Office (RCC Cosmetology, Coil School for the Arts, MVC Center for Human Performance, and NC Kineseology and Human Performance Center). Some projects would need to be requalified in the state's queue.
