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7:44 aye amber risby yes uh member t aye member ball all right and i will also 7:51 give a high vote that is unanimous seven zero all right 7:56 moving right along next is the measure c financial update 8:02 uh we have two items under that project commitment summer report as of june 30th 8:07 thank you committee chair um 8:24 okay so here we have the project movement summary report this is a financial report but the summary of 8:30 activities through june 22 the highlight sections that reflect any 8:35 kind of financial transactions and then reports into the last meeting so here 8:42 in the cash on hand we have a reduction of cash in the amount of about 3.4 million dollars 8.47 this is mainly due to the bank clark training center in the amount of 3.1 million dollars 8:53 the student services renovation project at greater valley college is the amount of 173 000 8:59 and a life science reconstruction project at work riverside city college is 76 000 9:07 here under most projects in progress project line and in the contingency 9:14 environment excuse me they both have changed by about 200 000 9:19 and this is due to the change in scope of work of the student services renovation project in green valley 9:25 college 9:35 [Music] in addition to those changes we also had 9:42 some changes on the other non-measure seeking limited funding sources 9:53 so we see a change of about 1.2 million uh independent performing dollar college 9:59 this is again due to the change in the scope of work and the amount of one million dollars 10:05 and the new hvac system you know a thousand dollars these will be addressed by the same 10:11 later in his presentation and that concludes my report for this and questions 10:26 then we move on to letter b is that also perfect 10:44 that i have occurred between april and june of 22. so right here we have the project 10:51 commitments and the remaining uncommitted funds changed for marine valley college they both exchanged 10:56 lending over 200 thousand dollars there were also some changes in the non-measure c budget 11:03 for this particular report in the amount of 1.2 million dollars both of these changes were related to 11:09

the verna valley college student services renovation project as previously discussed and this funeral

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11:15 will be addressed by the same leader in this uh presentation so that concludes our report do you have 11:21 any questions any questions from me so we're good thank you so much for the 11:27 report appreciate it all right so next up is the measure c 11:32 project update 11:52 for the student service 11:59 um 12:21 [Music] you know 12:34 was 12:40 so the first floor originally included the upper portion um to renovate the upper portion of the 12.47 student service opening however during the design the college decided to 12:54 renovate the wall of washing to improve the other services through the services that used to be located in the 13:00 wonderland and bring those programs to the fitness space 13:13 [Music] 13:32 question you look like you might be pondering the question yeah so just a really quick uh 13:38 guick question and so what happens to the the older area are 13:44 you gonna be using that 13:52 [Music] 13:58 um 14:04 [Music] 14:15 is there uh i guess you said it was old miners or old portables i take it so getting rid 14:21 of the portables saving money over time or is that i guess why the change was made to well um 14:43 it was overlooked originally in the design and then we would probably design 14:48 we they call it decided to bring those factions to the you know closed um 15:01 area for all student services so you have a welcome center and you have the all the student services functions 15:08 all located in a very central 15:18 makes sense i guess but you mentioned it was just that part of it was just overlooked in the original design of 15:23 somebody forgot the designer of the architecture oh hey there's those three services outside we forgot to put 15:29

those in there was a very schematic design by playing you know when the phone was approved but must be done

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15:34 through the actual design and probably measuring all the problems 15:53 go to bid and you understand what the full costs are associated with it and then over time there's available resources that were 16:00 identified to build uh increases so it evolved over a period of time 16:07 and it might just share it's over time also new services are identified and i 16:12 thought part of that could be that there was new services 16:18 that's correct any other questions or comments from the committee okay thank you maybe just a general 16:24 comment you'll notice a short report from the financial side of 16:29 the short report here that's just kind of endemic with the tailing down of the available measure 16:36 so you know you'll kind of probably see this trend continue 16.41yeah there's not much money left i think there's three million dollars right in the in the contingency so okay thank you 16:47 um 17:10 up 17:19 uh the first one is the life science physical science reconstruction project for the business and the 17:25 computer information the project or cvsa approval and working 17:32 drawings for proof ideas actually last month right we are currently in the bid and 17:39 the bid and our bids are due next week so we are helping 17:54 the first one is the student services renovation um as mentioned 18:15 um the other project is zencard training center phase one uh we are currently 18:21 under construction about 75 we anticipate the final substitute 18:28 completion by uh august in the world 18:34 so um 18:45 and when is the anticipated award date for the life science rfp um i would say by october 18:52 well the board will approve the project in august um august 16th that's what's in the board 18:58 but we cannot proceed until we get the state fund because we don't have assistance 19:05 for approval so that's about 30 days so your evaluation of the rfps will be done by august for the board to 19:11 then give their approval and then waiting for the student which usually takes them about 30 days 19.27 [Music]

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19:35 um well during the design we have done a lot of volumes well 19:41 and we also anticipated the reasonable inflation usually three you know four percent okay um now the inflation is 19:49 about seventy percent [Music] 20:02 [Music] we have also an ad alternate and direct development in our bid 20:08 for things that are not programmatic that we're not running you know educational programs um in case 20:16 this project comes forward 20:31 and i would imagine contractors are putting in uh allowances for inflation allowances 20:37 that's what i've seen in my own work right there that's happening quite a bit i just actually listened to our report 20:43 yesterday that some of the steel and you know steel and 20.49 blunder has been declining the last a month so that's what they could remember 21:11 relief any other questions regarding the board 21:18 reports or the project summary status oh great thank you so much for it thank 21:23 you [Music] all right moving along to 21:29 item six which is business from committee members the first one is a review of the 2021-22 21:37 cboc annual report and i'm gonna pass this over to you oh 21:42 yeah i'll put you on the spot by chancellor goldberg she likes me she like she has to be on camera so that's 21:47 what we love we wanted to give her a chance to be on camera 21:54 in the included packet i was a draft uh annual report for the last year and included 22:00 the minutes for the meetings that most of you uh were in into cash on 22:06 i don't believe there's anything of substance to share their minutes were all 22:12 previously approved there was one image that was included in the draft that you saw that we will uh that has already 22:17 been switched out before it goes to the board for um approval well for filing after you all approve it um we had a 22:25 picture of the veterans resource center from norco that was not funded by measure c dollars it doesn't make sense 22:31 for that to be we'd like to take credit that would be great right a good picture 22:36 assembly member says yeah 22:46 that change will be switched out before it moves forward to the board we'll make sure that you all get an electronic copy 22:52 and to review um other than that 22:57

it's there for your action and then from there it will go forward to the board

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23:03 thank you next uh is the facility planning and development measure c project 23.10 site who will be did we need to approach that yeah 23.17 oh it just says information only on the agenda so that's why i didn't it's just an information okay okay 23:24 because you've actually already signed everything so after today then we actually got rid of the signature 23:30 we'll take it to the board and they uh they file it 23:38 so then the facility planning and development measures project sites we wanted to share this with you some 23:44 upgrade updates to the website continue to happen uh [Music] 23:54 it's fancier definitely fancier information is 23:59 easy to locate on each of the projects and a good image 24.05for each one of them so it was good appreciated in his team very nice very nice thanks nice for the 24:12 public to see exactly what it was versus on paper when you have an image 24:18 hits home a little bit more okay perfect thank you looks great 24:24 uh and the last matter of business is just a thank you to everyone on the committee 24:30 because everyone signed up again uh to re-up uh for another two-year term so uh 24:37 nice to see everyone still around the table since uh most of us were uh 24:42 with our our term what expired last in between these last two meetings so a thank you to all for for continuing your 24:50 service so appreciate it yes i just want to join you 24:55 in thanking all of you for serving in this important function i think that 25.01[Music] we don't sometimes we take things for granted 25:07 because all of you are volunteering your times to support the district 25:12 to realize this mission and as we see only a small glimpse in these 25:19 isolated reports but we play a much bigger role when we look at where rccb has been 25:25 where it's going and the logic of what drives us you can see from all 25:31 the projects we are trying to consolidate student services to make it much much simpler 25:37 to design things in relation to the guided pathways we have 25:43 very high ambitions to double our success rate in five years to increase our access rate 25.49 that way and uh you know our recent endeavors to expand 25:54

into a trade [Music] the design

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25:59 that uh you all play so i don't want it to be to be viewed as these are sort of 26:06 isolated compartmentalizing you're part and parcel of that total vision 26:11 and the level of inspiration that you provide us and the courage that 26:16 we take because we have this kind of support to dream big and to push the envelope 26:22 even further is is very important so i just want everyone to uh to realize 26:29 how important function you all do for us and uh and how much we appreciate it's 26:34 just unfortunate that the two words thank you have limitations we can't say more 26:41 uh sometimes i say that words are inadequate to fully express our deepest gratitude so thank you again 26:48 thank you appreciate it thank you for everyone we're happy to do our part so 26:54thank you all right uh any other comments uh from committee members or things for our next 27:01 meeting i have a couple questions yeah i read 27:06 i think it was in the press enterprise a while back the football team is playing in paris or something 27:13 is that yeah i don't know who would paris california 27:19 unfortunately yes they're not going to france every week but they're playing it somewhere they're not playing at wheelock is yeah 27:26 i don't know where i i'm sorry i don't know their ranges that they made but we do have an issue a safety issue as it 27:32 relates to the turf um we also have an issue to attract that 27:39 we're currently addressing vote so they have to make other arrangements for safety reasons 27:46 at different locations intelligent safety effects the plan that we're currently working on 27:53 is to uh have it completely ready to go 28:02 okay because it seems to me and i i've read the bond original measure c 28:10 two years ago when i first got on but wasn't there money to fix wheelock in the original bond 28:18 to convert the breast the grass field 28.23 field as well as the trap to resurface not the stadium 28:32 and so when they redid the surface a few years ago after the flood they just did a crappy job or 28:38 well it's been it's been 15 years 28:56 well that shouldn't last they didn't do a complete uh uh redo of the field all the time 29.03 to mitigate the damage and so they replaced 29:09 you know the chirp itself they replace you know the mix that goes inside of it right

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29:16 i don't believe this touch so the sand and whatever it is underneath there 29.22 materials to form the base and that i believe probably contributed to part of the 29:28 issue but it didn't extend it as long as we were hoping that the life cycle of those turf fields 29:36 um 10 to 12 years i think yeah so we're right about that point 29:42 unless you're some pro stadium that pulls them in and out every week right yeah yeah unfortunately you know 29:49 having known that this was cunning we weren't having 29:58 okay gotcha yeah so the plan that we're looking at right now is to 30:03 you know make the purchase of a turf material itself on its own and then 30:08 contract for the installation and the speed of the process because i wanted to give you some of the 30:14 measure c money that's contingency because it's still the same kind of project it 30:20 of understood money is ourselves spoken for we're working on applying 30:28 all the resources that we need to fix that um which will be presented to our boards 30:51 [Music] 31:02 fix the stadium itself because it's like the 50 yard line is like over here 31:08 [Music] that is our next that's our next ball 31:14 oh yeah 50 million oh yeah 31:26 we don't want it to trigger those issues associated with accessibility right 31:45 back to the citizens in 2024. we need a big lotto ticket there 31:53 wow any other questions or comments from committee members 31:59 all right all right thank you member petty uh we will adjourn at 3 31. thank you so much 32:06 thank you thank you thank you everyone 32:17 [Music] 32:32 [Music] 33:29 you
