Trustee Blumenthal thanked all faculty, staff, administrators and students for their work on reopening the campuses and congratulated the RCC Tiger football team on winning.

Trustee Hedrick reported that he attended the Foundation meeting this morning and thanked Ms. Goldware and Ms. Wilson for their work and suggested that perhaps having more staff would help in raising more money and inquired as to whether one-time money can help with that. He expressed concern that students are being charged fees from online platform 3rd parties to access course information, inconsistency in applying policies to students across the district, COVID cleaning protocol, staffing shortages and the ongoing classification study and other vaccine related topics.

Trustee Vackar thanked the speakers for sharing their thoughts and expressed that she is happy the students have returned to continue their studies and become more productive in whatever they choose to do, commented on the budget update and grants reporting, and thanked her colleagues for their time and dedication to sitting on various committees.

Trustee Alcala thanked everyone at every level for all the work they are doing and how flexible they've been at every step and for meeting the needs of our students. He expressed concern that the inconsistency of messaging is still an issue and once again asked for consistency going forward. Welcomes the opportunity to meet with student groups on campus. Looks forward to continuing projects and discussions across the district. Attended sporting events and was glad to see the excitement of the athletes, the band, their families and the community.

Trustee Figueroa reiterated that trustees may visit the campuses at any time, but should notify the chancellor's office so the colleges are not caught off guard. She congratulated President Anderson on an impromptu visit to RCC by an international sister city who were very impressed by the welcome they received. She also communicated that the inconsistent messaging is an accreditation issue that Update from Members of the Board of Trustees on Business of the Board

needs to be addressed. She announced that prior CCLC CEO Scott Lay passed away.
