We've met with a group with whom the district has a longstanding relationship to see where they might be able to help with Guided Pathways. A very engaging and constructive discussion was held with the Sheriff, focused on preserving and maintaining our partnership that spans over seven decades, with Ben Clark Training Center (BCTC) and the County of Riverside. We also want to expand, as evidenced by the BCTC groundbreaking today, marking the first building on district land.
