### **Supervisor John Tavaglione** **2<sup>nd</sup> District** **Riverside County**

John Tavaglione was elected to represent the 2nd District in 1995 and currently is vice-chairman of the Board of Supervisors.

Supervisor Tavaglione has been credited for his leadership in regional transportation issues, community and economic development, and for his strong fiscal and organizational management skills.
