Riverside Aquatics Complex Swim Program

Starting Blocks is a community-wide public-private partnership that will provide swimming, water safety and nutritional instruction at no charge to disadvantaged students, and introduce the many benefits provided by participating in aquatics activities.

Construction of the **Riverside Aquatics Complex** will provide a three-pool facility that includes a premier practice and competitive venue for young athletes in our community and the adjacent Cutter Pool facility that offers two smaller pools for aquatic fitness, RCCD Community Education's Learn to Swim program, and other uses that foster community enrichment and development. In addition, the opening of the Complex is an opportunity to expand programs that teach children who are non-swimmers to swim in a safe environment with quality instruction. This is particularly important given statistics that indicate children from non-swimming households are eight times more likely to be at risk of drowning.

Starting Blocks will be launched in June 2011 with a two-week program, thanks to Tilden-Coil Constructors, Riverside Unified School District, the Kiwanis Club of Riverside, and The Assistance League of Riverside who have joined Riverside Community College District and the RCCD Foundation as project partners. With your help, we can expand and eventually endow **Starting Blocks** to ensure that disadvantaged children in our region can learn to swim, will be water safe, and can reap the many benefits of participation in youth competitive aquatics.
