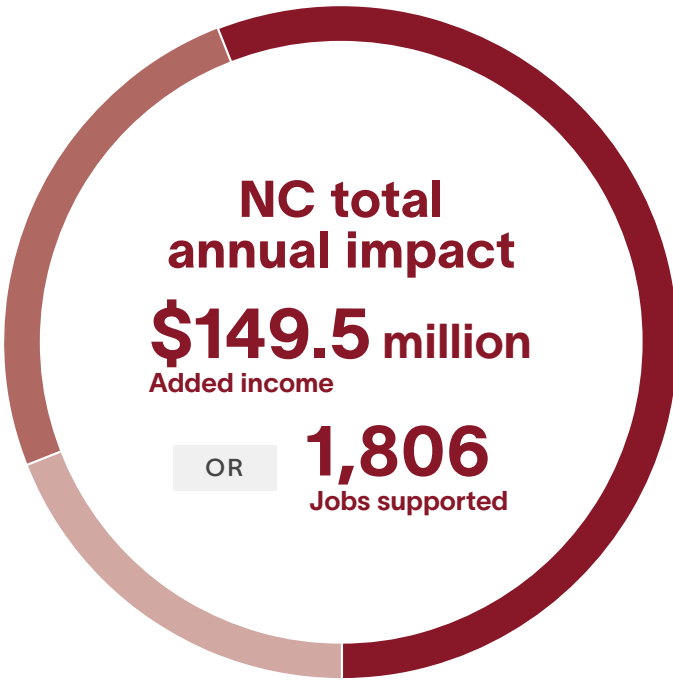

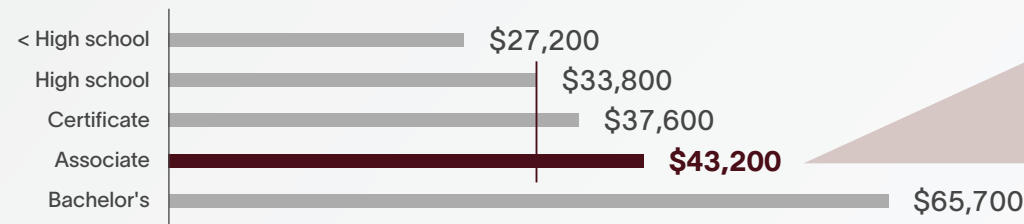

For every **\$1...**



Students gain **\$7.70** in lifetime earnings
