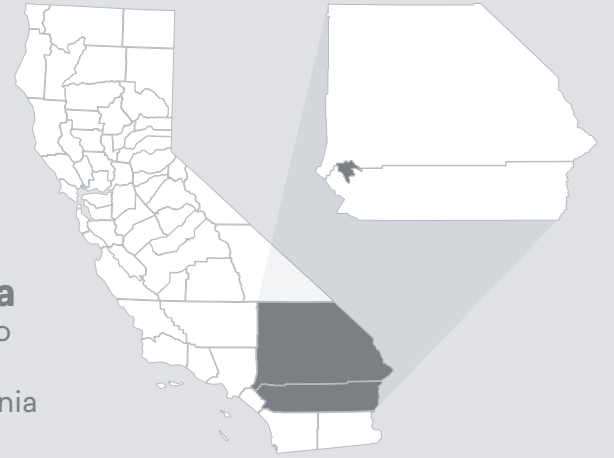

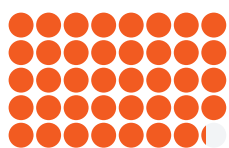
Alumni impact

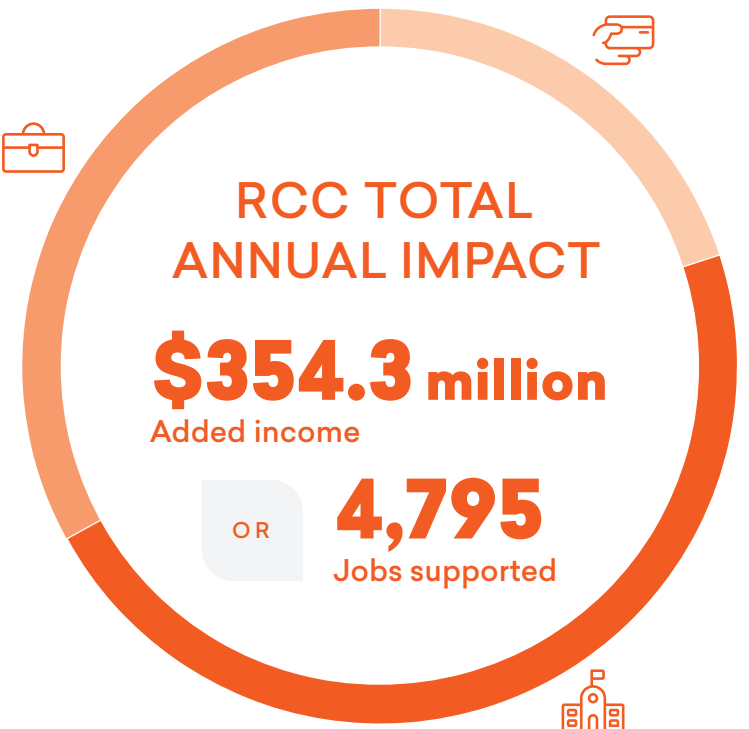
Student spending impact

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

For every \$1...

Students gain **\$6.70** in lifetime earnings



Taxpayers gain **\$1.40** in added tax revenue and public sector savings



Society gains **\$8.50** in added income and social savings



The average associate degree graduate from RCC will see an increase in earnings of **\$10,100** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma or equivalent working in California.
