Upon discussion regarding rationale for local certificates applying for state-wide approval, it was discovered that one potential area of concern is that transcripts generated for students within RCCD don't include much information regarding what they achieved during their educational journey at RCCD.

The lack of information on student transcripts also may hinder the tracking of success.

It was decided that Burchett would draft language for the District CC to consider, formally asking the District Academic Senate to sponsor a resolution calling for all RCCD transcripts to contain any award, honor, certificate or degree granted by any college within the District.
