Reports from Colleges

- 1. Moreno Valley
 - a. The draft of the new DE addendum was shared at the last college meeting.
- 2. Norco
 - a. Information about the emergency DE form was shared, and the committee was informed that a new standard form would also be coming forward soon. A few emergency forms have already been submitted by faculty.



b. One of the questions received was if the form needs to be submitted by the discipline faculty at each college or if it is district wide. For example, the different colleges may have different intentions on how to offer the same course. It was recommended that all DE options be selected and then each college determine whether they want to offer any courses in a specific format.

3. Riverside

- a. The DE addendum forms were also shared at the Riverside curriculum committee.
- b. It was announced that the curriculum institute will be fully online. There is still a registration fee of \$200.
- c. Kelly Douglass indicated she wanted to communicate with faculty the courses that absolutely must have a DE addendum due to being scheduled in the summer so that faculty are aware of courses that will have immediate deadlines, versus course that can have an addendum proposed later on.

Action Items

1. Curriculum Proposals

Discussion Items

- 1. General Education Questions: Whole Disciplines, Criteria, and Removals Kelly Douglass
 - a. The Academic Senate has not yet officially dissolved the Academic Standards committee into a workgroup of DCC, so the discussion regarding removing whole disciplines from the GE listing in the catalog and adding in specific courses that are GE may need to be delayed.
 - i. Ann Pfeifle Recommended this topic be kept on the agenda, but revisited in the fall.
 - b. Brian Johnson This may not actually be a standards issue. Curriculum approves the addition or removal of general education courses, and DCC is just asking for clarification on which classes within a discipline are considered general education.
 - c. Ann It would be great for students and faculty to see lists of specific courses that are approved for GE. There should be a unified, streamlined way to communicate that information to students and faculty.
 - d. This topic will be delayed to the first DCC meeting in September.
- 2. Riverside Non-Credit Music Courses Kelly Douglass
 - a. Three non-credit music courses were approved at the very last meeting of 2019 and they were sent to the Board and were approved. Kelly Douglass and Steven Schmidt determined the courses would need significant revisions before they could be offered. MUS faculty had used a college that offered these courses as a model, but it was determined that there were issues with the non-credit courses at that college.
 - b. Casandra Greene indicated she did not submit to the courses to COCI, has not entered them into catalog, and is awaiting confirmation from Kelly Douglass and



Steven Schmidt before moving forward with them.

- c. Ann Pfeifle Board approved courses do not need to be submitted to the state or placed in the catalog if there is no intention to offer them at all. Faculty can perform a major modification in order to revise them.
- d. The classes should not be offered and whenever faculty want to revise them, they will need to submit major modifications in Meta.
- 3. Non-Credit Certificate Set Up in Colleague Kelly Douglass
 - a. This was a question that was raised at the Riverside curriculum committee earlier in the year. What is the status of the ability to generate non-credit certificates out of colleague?
 - i. Casandra Greene Riverside curriculum faculty had concerns about the significant amount of non-credit that was proposed without the infrastructure in place to support it. However, it appears that in the fall, students should be able to register for non-credit courses.
 - ii. Bryan Nicol The coordinators will begin building non-credit certificates into Colleague in the next two weeks. Once the certificates have been created, they will reach out to Beth Watts and Jeanine Gardner to test awarding.
