 - a. Kelly Douglass recommended an annual or periodic review where any edits or changes to the Curriculum Handbook can be made and approved at a single time. An approval in March, for example, could be for the entire calendar year.
 - b. Brian Johnson recommended that Steven Schmidt be present for discussion and a vote. The committee agreed to bring the topic as an Action Item to Tech Review.



Discussion Items

- 1. Non-Credit Update Thea Quigley
 - Non-credit planning is continuing with Admissions and Records, IT, Counseling, and Marketing. Each workgroup has representation from all colleges including faculty.
 - b. Recommendations are being compiled into a document that will be shared with appropriate parties.
 - c. Dr. Zhai will be leading non-credit strategic planning group, which will start in spring. Faculty members are being identified to participate in the group. District Academic Senate was consulted and asked for representation. Riverside thus far is lacking a representative.
 - i. Current participants include Jennifer Floerke from Moreno Valley and Adam Martin from Norco.
 - d. At the Academic Senate meeting, presidents indicated the desire for more professional development for faculty. Thea has reached out to the State Academic Senate who may have a trainer available to send to the colleges. The possibility of bringing in a consultant (preferably full-time faculty member) to visit each college to perform professional development is also under consideration.
 - i. If anyone has any suggestions or preferences for the consultant, please let Thea know.
 - ii. Kelly Douglass recommended checking with Mt. San Antonio College to see if they have anyone available as they already have a large non-credit program.
 - iii. Thea indicated that there may be also be the possibility of hosting a conference within the district, similar to what Mt. SAC has done in the past.
 - e. Additionally, Thea is looking at the possibility of additional professional development for classified staff as well.
 - f. Kelly Douglass indicated that there may have been some confusion regarding the credit-by-exam policy, however, it seems to be settled now. There was the misconception that the credit-by-exam policy would cause a change in records showing students took a credit version of a course when they did not, which is not the case. Rather, if the student petitions for credit-by-exam, they earn credit towards their degree. The existing policy allows individual faculty members to control what "by exam" means. It could be a comprehensive exam, a total sum of the course work from the non-credit version of the course, or another option. It would be up to the individual faculty member to decide.
- 2. Riverside Non-Credit Music Courses Kelly Douglass
 - a. Requesting that the three non-credit courses MUS 854, 855, and 868 be held at the DCC level to allow for further review.
- 3. Repeatability in Meta and Colleague Bryan Nicol
 - a. There may be instances where the incorrect value has been entered into the repeatability field in Meta, which is then entered into Colleague. The repeatability



field should indicate the number of times a course can be taken after a student takes the course the initial time.
