Reports from Colleges

- 1. Moreno Valley
 - a. The first meeting of the term went well. The COR Review Tool will be placed on the next agenda. It has been sent out to faculty for review, but there has been no official vote yet.
 - b. The Moreno Valley Tech Review will be changed from weekly to bi-monthly.
- 2. Norco
 - a. The itemized GE list was provided to the committee, and it was stressed that members should have discussion with their respective disciplines and respond. Members were reminded to complete the form if adding classes to the list.



b. The COR Review Tool was provided to the committee. The committee had no feedback.

3. Riverside

- a. Riverside's first meeting was mixed face-to-face and remote. The meeting went well with special thanks to Steven Schmidt.
- b. The COR Review Tool will go to the Teaching and Learning Council on Monday. Feedback will be brought back after the meeting.
- c. Open Equity Shares continues to be a standing item on the committee's agenda, which is resulting in good discussion on the topic.
- d. Questions were raised regarding the emergency distance education (DX) approvals and if they would be applied to WIN/SPR. Kelly Douglass encouraged the committee to submit standard DE proposals and stated that if there is an emergency closure, then yes, the DX would apply.

Action Items

1. Curriculum Proposals

Discussion Items

- 1. Implementation of DE/DX Proposals Steven Schmidt/Kelly Douglass
 - a. Brian Johnson The VPAA at Norco discussed the DX proposal form in the senate meeting. As it reads currently, it states that DX applies in the event of a college/district closure. The district is currently in a quasi-state where it is not officially closed, yet courses are still being delivered online under the DX approval. The request at senate was to update the language regarding what constitutes an emergency and what constitutes a closure so that it is clearer.
 - b. Kelly Douglass In 21SPR, the curriculum chairs and academic senate presidents released a statement regarding the spirit in which the DX approval should apply and at that time stated that 21FAL should be treated as a transitional semester. While the language may be updated, we would want to be careful that it is not changed to where an individual faculty member could use the DX for an exception. This is why the campus closure language was so strong. The language should clearly indicate a college based emergency, not an individual faculty emergency.
 - c. Kelly Douglass We may be in the same situation as we were in 21SPR, but now with more information.
 - d. Ann Pfeifle Until the governor states that the pandemic emergency designation is removed, or until locally the administration contradicts the governor, the DX should apply for WIN/SPR because we are not yet out of the pandemic.
 - e. Kelly Douglass The disciplines should carefully consider the distance education approval of their courses in an itemized way. It is not a good idea to say we are in an emergency forever to continually utilize DX every term, but for winter and spring if students are required to be vaccinated and everyone is required to wear masks, this appears to be an emergency. Students may also not want to enroll into



- face-to-face courses until they no longer have to wear a mask. If disciplines want to stay online, they need to propose the course for standard DE approval.
- f. Brian Johnson The DX approvals should not apply as the colleges are not closed. Courses are being taught face-to-face, so any courses being taught online should have a standard DE approval.
- g. Steven Schmidt We also should be cautious of setting any precedent that then becomes more and more ambiguous. An emergency should be a declared emergency, not a personal emergency, but there could be a situation where a course is moved to online that may not be due to a campus closure. Faculty should be encouraged to propose their courses for standard distance education.
- h. Kelly Douglass We can also remind faculty that just because an online approval exists does not mean they can be made to teach via DE.
- i. The committee agreed to prepare a statement and/or recommendation for the next Academic Senate meeting.
