# **Discussion Items**

- 1. Noncredit Update Bryan Nicol
  - a. Dr. Zhai at the district wanted to pass on to the District Curriculum Committee that a non-credit workgroup, which includes faculty involvement, is working on a strategic plan to expand non-credit curriculum in the district. The workgroup plans to present to the curriculum committee in the spring.
- 2. ERP Questions for Chairs Casandra Greene
  - a. The new ERP has a limit for course titles of 75 characters. This was a concern as it will impact curriculum, and we wanted to obtain the committee's feedback.
  - b. Ann Pfeifle We should not allow technology to drive curricular decisions, but faculty would need to be contacted if they are impacted.
  - c. Kelly Douglass The code cannot be rewritten to expand the character limit?
    - i. Casandra Green The vendor is adamant that this character limit cannot be expanded, and will require coordinators to use a 'school defined field' in the system. The concern is that that the school defined fields are informational and not functional, and is a recommendation the vendor is frequently providing regarding curriculum.
  - d. Jeannie Kim Many of the reports that the system generates will be by the district's design, but we do need to have a field that will allow for the full description of the course, and we can do that through the defined fields.
  - e. Ann Pfeifle One concern would be the more we customize, the more likely we are to end up in the same situation we are in with Colleague.
    - i. Casandra In this case, it wouldn't be a customization, but an additional field we add to the system.
  - f. Jeannie Kim In addition, there are discussions that are ongoing in regards to the integration of Meta with the new ERP so that Meta data is transferred to the ERP automatically. This would help reduce the amount of manual labor. Technology out of the box will drive a change in how we do business, but the hope is that it will end up becoming better in the long run.
  - g. Casandra Greene As future issues arise, they will be brought to the committee's attention for feedback.
