ENP Entrepreneurship

Rationale: Presently, students are able to earn three stackable certificates in Entrepreneurship but they are unable to earn an

associate degree. This program would allow students to complete an Associate Degree of Science in Entrepreneurship. The entrepreneurship program provides students broad, intellectual, practical skills that demonstrate the ability to apply knowledge and concepts related to identifying business opportunities, evaluating ideas, assessing the markets, and exploring risks and rewards. Additionally, students will develop a business model canvas and pitch their business idea. Through a series of courses that include hands-on and experiential learning, students develop knowledge and

skills that serve as a springboard to start, run, and grow their own business.
