Although it does fulfill the C1 elective category, it is one of the less popular music courses listed in that group. Historically, when offered at MVC, it has never filled. In fact, its highest fill rate was 73.8% back in 2014 and it has averaged 48.3% since then. This includes a significant drop to 18.2% in 2021 and 19% in 2022. Additionally, RCC has not offered this course in many years and has no plans to offer it in the future.

ADJ 14 [Advanced Criminal Investigation](#)

Rationale: The existing ADJ-14 course, Advanced Criminal Investigations, is being requested for exclusion from RCC's Catalog due to a restructuring in the discipline. ADJ-14 is currently the only ADJ course that has a pre-requisite, ADJ-13 Criminal Investigations. Currently these two classes have more outcomes linked to crime scene investigation than the various specializations and technical aspects of criminal investigations; crime scene investigations are just one area of focus upon many underneath of the umbrella of criminal investigations. In order to rectify this, to ensure students are obtaining both rigorous current legal education along with industry-leading best practices in investigative skillsets, RCC has completed a major modification on the ADJ-13 curriculum and has created a new course, ADJ-28 Crime Scene Investigation, to ensure students remain both academically and professionally competitive. The establishment of this new course, along with the modifications to existing curriculum, are more professionally relevant for students. In reviewing all of the program's offerings, removal of ADJ-14, allows for more relevant programming within the curriculum without adding any need to resources/class sections.
