1. Curriculum Proposals

Discussion Items

- 1. Emergency DE Proposal Guidance Steven Schmidt
 - a. Now that the committee is starting to receive Emergency DE proposals, when



- entering them into Meta, Steven will be using the DX acronym. Steven also recommended that the name of the proposal in Meta be based on the category of the proposal, for example, DX 1 Unit Ensemble and DX 2 Unit Ensemble. While DE is usually placed after the number, DX will be placed before the number.
- b. The first proposals received had cross listed courses from one college. Steven updated the form to remove "College" and replaced it with "Discipline" as distance education approval is district wide. On the form, it would be good for faculty to acknowledge any cross listed courses, but each form should be a proposal for one discipline only. The form has been updated on the RCC website.
- c. Sheila Pisa sent the committee some sample proposals that will be posted on the Riverside curriculum website as well.
- d. Kelly Douglass The chairs may want to meet before the fall curriculum training to discuss expectations for DE proposals, so that the college curriculum committees are evaluating them in the same way. Some committee members may have limited experience in teaching online and may not be sure what to look for in a DE proposal.
 - i. Ann Pfeifle Agreed. Also, Moreno Valley is trying to work more closely with the DE committee and is hopeful it will be a continuing, ongoing conversation.
- e. Steven Schmidt Some items that may need to be discussed include the differences between the batch and individual proposals. How are the courses integrated with the content? If the courses have different SLOs, what does that integration look like? How detailed or general does the proposal need to be? Perhaps this should be discussed with the DE committees so that there is a unified explanation of content to help faculty in the fall.

2. Work Experience – Brian Johnson

- a. At the last Tech Review meeting, ADJ-200 was on the agenda with a different COR from WKX-200. Last time the 200 courses were modified, they were all cross listed with identical course outlines. What should be done now? Can the CORs be different with the cross listings removed? Should they all be the same?
- b. Gail Zwart The courses were cross listed with the same COR due to a lack of students to fill classrooms. The class may not always be discipline specific, but the course is ultimately about job skills. If disciplines choose to have a version of the course that is not cross listed, they may want to consider a different number.
- c. Ashley Etchison Having the courses not be cross listed would be difficult on the instructor. Having to follow multiple CORs with different SLOs would be difficult as students from different disciplines are in the same classroom.
- d. Kelly Douglass When this was discussed last year, there were disciplines that wanted more discipline specific content for their work experience course. The comment was made that if they un-cross listed their course, they would no longer be a part of the WKX program and the discipline would need to start their own WKX program. For example, the ADJ faculty want to have their ADJ-200 course be updated with very specific ADJ language. If they did this, could ADJ faculty continue to participate in the overall work experience program as long as it's an ADJ faculty member teaching the course and it is not scheduled at the same time



as the other WKX courses?

- i. Gail Zwart They could, but they would need to follow the guidelines in the WKX manual, which may not be easy. The guidelines would need to be followed specifically in the way that students are reported in how they meet with employers, how students meet objectives, how documentation is maintained, etc. The bigger issue could be who is administrating the program.
- ii. Kelly Douglass The feedback received was that ADJ would like to have the course be ADJ specific so they can cover discipline specific issues in the classroom. Kelly's response was that the faculty member may need to run their own WKX program, and the faculty member needed further clarification. If the course is un-cross listed, the faculty would need to do the administering?
 - 1. Gail Zwart Yes, and they would need to understand they get paid very differently. They are paid per student. There could also be a workload difference that they may not be prepared for.
- e. Patty Worsham We also have staffing issues due to the minimum qualifications. For example, an instructor could have minimum qualifications for BUS, but not ACC. In WKX you could have multiple students, but they could be in different disciplines.
 - i. Gail Zwart This is no longer true because all the 200 courses are cross listed. The instructor needs to have the minimum qualifications in only one area, unless they un-cross list the course. This allows for different disciplines to be taught by a single instructor. If ACC was not cross listed, then you would need to have an instructor with an ACC FSA.
- f. Kelly Douglass If a faculty member wants to consider un-cross listing their course and wants to make an informed decision, who is the best individual to reach out to for further information?
 - i. Ashley Etchison Faculty members can reach out to Ashley Etchison or David Schlanger for more information.
- g. Brian Johnson If we remove the cross listing, but instead put a cross discipline, would that solve the issue? Would we be able to have different looking course outlines that could fall within the same program?
 - i. Gail Zwart Having a class of students with a large number of different SLOs could be very difficult for the instructor. Creating a cross-discipline probably would not be the best option.
- h. Kelly Douglass Because the courses are on a two-year review cycle, who is the best individual to assist with the curriculum updates every two years?
 - i. Patty Worsham It will be Patty Worsham, she is the department co-chair.
- i. Brian Johnson For now, we should tell faculty to not change the 200 level courses unless they want to run their own work experience program.
- 3. Honors and Non-Honors Equivalents Bryan Nicol
 - a. The committee clarified that while honors and their non-honor partner courses may not be cross listed, they are considered equivalents. Students should only be able to enroll into and receive credit for one.



- 4. ESL DE Approvals Bryan Nicol
 - a. Earlier in the term, ESL 46-50 and 846-850 were approved for hybrid delivery. Prior to the proposal being activated, the discipline voted to approve online delivery as well. The committee agreed this would be fine to implement.
