- 1. Posting draft versions of 2019 Coversheets and Curriculum Handbook Steven Schmidt
 - a. "Working" complete drafts of the Handbook, Cover Sheets, and Proposal Forms



- have been posted to the RCC Curriculum Committee website. Documents have been watermarked as draft. District Educational Services will post a link on the district curriculum website.
- b. Faculty and colleagues should be encouraged to take a look at the drafts and note any comments, concerns, or edits to bring to the September 24th college level meeting. Committees are encouraged to vote to approve the handbook at that meeting, which will then be voted on at the following District Curriculum Committee meeting. The handbook will then be taken as an informational item to the Academic Senate, Executive Cabinet, Committee on Teaching and Learning, and the Board of Trustees.
- c. The committee will work to identify any administrative policies that are impacted by the policies outlined by the handbook (which may include, but not be limited to policies 4020, 4021, 4022 as well as the Program Approval process that was established in 2011). Revisions to any impacted policies will be drafted and proposed for approval, but the handbook should remain in draft form until any policy changes are approved.
- d. Committee members raised the issue of the unit calculation policy not clearly stating a calculation and will research if the existing policy is sufficient or if any edits need to be proposed.
- 2. DEA Program Correction Sabina Fernandez
 - a. Courses in an existing DEA program were implemented this year with unit changes that did not impact the overall units of the program. The committee recommended that a modification to the program should be brought through the approval process to clarify these changes.
- 3. Brown Act Requirements Heather Edberg
 - a. The District Curriculum Committee is bound by the Brown Act, which requires that the agenda and any notes be posted and be available to the public. The agenda will need to be posted a full 72 hours in advance of the meeting with no additions or removals being made after the agenda is posted or at the time of the meeting.
- 4. Coordinator Procedures Bryan Nicol
 - a. Currently, proposals in Meta have TOPs codes listed in two different areas, which creates issues or confusion with submission to the Chancellor's Office, data entry into Colleague, and MIS reporting. The proposal was made that any existing proposals in Meta that lack a TOPs code on the Cover tab should be updated with the TOPs Code as entered into the Chancellor's Office Inventory.
 - b. District Educational Services will then reach out to Curricunet to ensure that the TOPs Code on the Cover tab of the proposal prints to the COR and that the field on the Codes and Dates tab is either removed, locked, or synced with the field on the Cover tab.
