- 3. Unit Calculation Ann Pfeifle
 - a. In working with ADJ faculty at Moreno Valley, Ann Pfeifle and faculty member Kristy Paine discovered that the existing unit calculator that is used district wide does not account for quarter units, but this was the calculator that Kristy Paine was originally instructed to use to calculate units for ADJ courses. Now that a second unit calculator has been developed that calculates in quarter unit calculations, it's important that the colleges are consistent in how unit values are calculated.
 - b. The ADJ courses currently in review have had any corrections made that were needed, but units have not been adjusted as changing units for the courses could impact certificate and degree programs. Additionally, there are regulations that prevent POST courses from being combined together so that the hours would calculate to half unit values.
 - c. Kelly Douglass indicated that in updating BP 4020, perhaps the language needs to indicate courses that have unit calculations that deviate from being award in half unit increments due to licensing requirements.
 - d. Heather Edberg stated that any changes in units could have an impact on student fees, faculty load, and financial aid.
 - e. Steven Schmidt stated that the PCAH indicates that colleges can award in increments smaller than .5 by local policy.
 - f. **Question:** At what point was the decision made that the ADJ courses offered at Ben Clark would be calculated using quarter units? Ann and faculty have looked for when the decision was initially made, and it appears to be a local decision.
 - g. **Question:** Does the district award in half unit increments with POST courses offered at the Ben Clark Training Center being an exception?
 - h. **Question:** Was there ever a documented decision that POST courses should be offered in quarter units? Ann indicated she has looked, but has not yet found a documented decision.
 - i. **Question:** How would ADJ programs at Moreno Valley be impacted if unit values were calculated in quarter units?
 - j. **Question:** What courses exist that would have to have unit values changed in the event that units were now calculated in quarter increments?
 - k. A task force may be needed for further discussion on unit calculations and the creation of a district wide policy.
 - 1. Dr. Mills stated she would bring this topic to the next VPAA meeting so the VPAAs are aware of it.
