It could also be used as 3 of the 6 units required for the Early Childhood Education Assistant Teacher Certificate.

This class currently rotates being offered as a day and then night class and as such, it is in high demand at the college.

In addition to this, it is also one of the possible courses that teachers in the K-12 system need to fulfill the mandatory 24 units in ECE in order for them to teach in Transition Kindergarten. Currently these students are limited to completing this course at night, on the weekends, or if they want on-line at another Community College in the state. Many of these teachers are opting out of taking this class due to availability, which is a of great concern as it is considered by the ECE faculty one of the most critical to enhance their understanding of developmentally appropriate teaching, understanding of equity and anti-bias curriculum development for children in the TK age range.

EAR 25 is a required class in most of our larger certificates and an elective in others. Many working professionals cannot attend class during the day and therefore take EAR 25 at night. This prevents them from completing in a timely manner.

Therefore, to provide more opportunity for students to complete this class, to meet the requirements set forth by the Californian Department of Education, and to meet the needs of our local work force, we want to offer it in a DE format, using fully on-line and hybrid models
