1. Curriculum Proposals

Discussion Items

1. AHS Approval Process – Rhonda Taube

- a. AHS was approved at Riverside in 2018 as Riverside was initially spearheading the projects as faculty were available. The project was put on hold at that time as it was unclear what the approval process was to move courses into the discipline.
- b. 18 major modifications have been launched to adjust the discipline acronym. AHS-6 is a new course that will be launched and cross-listed with ART-6. Rhonda Taube has been working with Casandra Greene to identify the programs that also need to be updated, including ADTs and AOE's.
- c. Bryan Nicol – There are currently no department chairs set up for AHS. The proposals at the department level will be 'stuck' until users are input to issue approvals.
- d. **Question:** What is the process for determining all the faculty members who have the appropriate FSA so that they can be appropriately set up in Meta?
- e. **Question:** What is the process for approving updates to AOE's?
 - i. Kelly Douglass – Several years ago, faculty formed a sub-group that reviewed AOE's and with any updates, but the question remains how AOE's are updated currently.
- f. **Question:** Is there a TOP's code change on these courses?
 - i. After some discussion, it was established that 1002.00 – Art, which is the current code for the courses, is the appropriate code and does not need to be changed.
 - ii. The Articulation Officers indicated that if the TOP's code were changed, that this would not impact articulation.
- g. **Question:** Would it be easier to create the courses as new courses that are cross-listed with the current ART discipline so that faculty with the ART FSA can continue teaching?
 - i. Nick Franco – This would have an impact on articulation, which could take one to two years for CSUGE/IGETC approval, course-to-course approval for major preparation.
- h. **Question:** Is the FSA for Art History different from Art?
 - i. Rhonda Taube – Yes, and the faculty are also currently working towards obtaining the appropriate FSA.
- i. **Question:** The courses involved appear on four different ADTs. Whose job is it to rewrite the narratives for the ADTs? The ADTs involved appear to be Studio Arts, Art History, Spanish (in the substitution list), and Elementary Teacher Education at Riverside.
 - i. Rhonda Taube indicated she had been working with Casandra to identify the programs impacted, and that she believed ADTs for the other colleges were also being updated. She stated she would investigate the substitution list for the Spanish ADT.
- j. **Question:** For future discipline creations, how is it made clear to faculty that the new discipline exists, is available for faculty to teach, and that the faculty interested to obtain the appropriate FSA?
 - i. Ann Pfeifle – With the creation of the Ethnic Studies discipline, the discipline at times is associated with history, but historically has been taught by sociologists. Whatever the process, it needs to be made clear that

faculty can seek to obtain the FSA.

- ii. Rhonda Taube – The process is through HR. Faculty can self-elect and work with HR if they meet the minimum qualifications. As department chair, Rhonda stated she reached out through the department to faculty, and also sought out faculty who had taught the courses under ART for a number of years so they could meet the minimum qualifications through equivalency.
- iii. Bryan Nicol – At which point in the discipline creation process should this happen?
 1. Kelly Douglass – Perhaps at the point that the discipline/discipline inclusion is created. The department chair must indicate which faculty members are to be included so that the appropriate faculty members are the ones reviewing and commenting on curriculum.
 2. Bryan Nicol – For AHS, the department chairs submitted the discipline inclusion form for RIV and MOV. Bryan stated he would reach out to the department chair at NOR to obtain approval, and that department chair approval would be sought in the future before updating Meta user accounts.
- iv. Brian Johnson – It appears to be the department’s job to find those faculty that have the FSA and to contact HR. Every year, HR also provides a statement asking faculty if their FSA is correct or if there are any others that need to be added. When the department schedules courses, faculty cannot be assigned unless they have the appropriate FSA.

2. New ERP: Impact on Catalog and Schedule – Jeannie Kim

- a. The new ERP will have an impact on catalog and schedule production. Our current catalog is a summer-to-spring catalog, and not a fall-to-summer catalog. While the topic of moving to a fall-to-summer calendar was discussed several years ago, the decision at that time was to not make a change to the starting time for the catalog. With the new ERP being implemented, it may be a good time to revisit this discussion.
- b. Because the RCCD calendar falls on two different academic years based on the four-year institution calendar, there is an impact on students especially regarding articulation. Most articulation approvals are effective in the fall, which creates problems for students taking classes in the summer. There could also be an impact with the implementation of ethnic studies.
- c. **Question:** Is there any reason why we should not change to a fall-to-summer catalog?
 - i. Kelly Douglass – Could the issue be budget related? The budget is on a summer to spring schedule.
 - ii. Jeannie Kim – That issue will need to be discussed with Aaron Brown in more details, but many institutions have a summer-to-summer fiscal year with the catalog still starting in the fall term.
- d. Ann Pfeifle – This is a discussion the articulation officers have brought up previously, and it may be a good change to implement.

- e. Bryan Nicol – Articulation beginning in the fall term while our catalog begins in the summer term also causes issues with scheduling and transcripts that are extremely difficult to correct.
3. Addendum Process for 2021-2022 – Jeannie Kim
 - a. In the past, the rolling addendum has helped the CTE programs in being more responsive to industry and community needs, however, having a continuous rolling addendum process that brings in new courses and programs as frequently as it has been will most likely be problematic with the new ERP.
 - b. An upload will need to be performed with the existing catalog and schedule into the new ERP. Since everything is built off the catalog, including EduNav and guided pathways, if the catalog is not kept relatively stable it could lead to problems in the next 18 months when the ERP goes live.
 - c. **Question:** During the transition period, would it be acceptable to have some sort of hiatus of publishing multiple addendums during the implementation of the ERP, allowing for perhaps one or two addendums over the course of an 18-month period? Additionally, how would we go about messaging this to faculty?
 - i. Ann Pfeifle – There will be some resistance from the VPAA at Moreno Valley along with CTE faculty. The CTE faculty are required to update their curriculum every two years, so having a hiatus of 18 months could be difficult. If one or two addendums can be published, this would be helpful. Additionally, just a few years ago there were no addendums.
 - ii. Bryan Nicol – Rolling addendums have been done for the past two cycles, being posted as necessary.
 - iii. Nick Franco – The rolling addendum has been great for Norco in ensuring new curriculum could be offered.
 - iv. Kelly Douglass – There will most likely be objections from CTE faculty and the VPAA from Riverside, but if we are just going back to a system of one or two addendums during the transition, this may be possible.
 - v. Ann Pfeifle – A major issue may include outside accreditors, such as the Sheriff's Department. Being unable to update curriculum would also have an impact on being able to stay competitive.
 1. Jeannie Kim – We may be able to make certain allowances in those cases where it is very specific and we may lose competitive edge, but to have a constant rolling addendum could lead to disorganization in the new ERP.
 - d. Jeannie Kim – This conversation will continue with the VPAA's. It's unclear if the process needs to be approved as there does not appear to be a formal record of approval previously.
4. AHS Discipline ADTs – Ellen Brown-Drinkwater and Casandra Greene
 - a. **Question:** Regarding the updates due to AHS, is there a way to expedite the approvals of the ADTs?
 - i. Ellen Brown-Drinkwater - There are no programmatic changes, only the change of the discipline to AHS. Could it be done as an info item to DCC?

- ii. Kelly Douglass – Is there a precedent for a ‘minor modification’ of programs? Perhaps the program could be reviewed at Tech Review and then moved to DCC?
 - b. Jeanne Howard – The information in the RCCD Curriculum Handbook is out of date, specifically the portion regarding program modifications. Until the document is updated, it may be beneficial to remove the handbook from the web so that faculty are not confused.
 - i. Bryan Nicol – The section on program modifications is out of date. The State Chancellor’s Office previously separated modified programs into ‘substantial’ and ‘non-substantial’ changes. This is no longer the case. Bryan drafted language to update the handbook and forwarded it to Steven and Brian.
 - c. Jeanne Howard – There are several documents that need to be obtained for program modifications, and it can create a delay in submitting items to Assist.
 - d. **Question:** Is there any concern regarding C-ID approval?
 - i. Ellen Brown-Drinkwater – Nick Franco can submit updates, and a ‘history’ feature has also been created. Approval should not be impacted.
