#### **Discussion Items**

- 1. Math 9, 109 and 35 Valerie Merrill and Sean Drake
  - a. Valerie Merrill The MAT discipline will no longer be offering MAT-35 in the future and instead will begin transitioning to MAT-9 and 109. MAT-35 is a prerequisite for courses across several disciplines, and those disciplines will need to update their CORs as MAT-35 will no longer be offered. They may need to replace the requisite with qualifying placement or that the requisite can be satisfied with completion of a higher-level course.
  - b. Kelly Douglass This change can be announced at the college curriculum meetings, but the disciplines will not be able to revise their CORs for the 22-23 catalog. This raises the question of what happens for fall enrollment? Students may need waivers where appropriate.
  - c. Brian Johnson Some disciplines may want to change the requisite from MAT-35 to MAT-9. Others may want to remove the requisite entirely.
  - d. Jeanne Howard There are some courses that will need to have it to ensure they do not lose articulation. There was some verbiage that was provided by the UC Office of the President that could be used instead. The approval for some courses for CID is intermediate algebra, so the skill would need to be listed.
    - i. Ellen Brown-Drinkwater AOs may be able to reach out to faculty to let them know what language needs to be updated.
  - e. Sean Drake One item of concern is the need to be careful with Statistics as it is not a substitute for MAT-35, particularly for the sciences and economics which may need certain skills from algebra, which is different from what they learn in statistics. Discipline experts may need to indicate particularly what they want to see on their CORs.
  - f. Nick Franco What's the plan with MAT 52?
    - i. Valerie Merrill This course is no longer offered.
    - ii. Nick These courses may also need to be addressed and have their CORs updated.
  - g. Carlos Lopez MAT-9 would represent a step up from intermediate algebra, so that may be the avenue for students, we'll just need to ensure students are directed appropriately.
- 2. IP/AP/CLEP Updates Ellen Brown-Drinkwater
  - a. Nick Franco Updates for IP/AP/CLEP exam articulation will be in the next catalog. Updates typically come from UC Office of the President, from the IGETC Standards Committee, and the CSU Chancellor's Office. Local application of tests is based on faculty input from the three colleges. This year there was a uniform updated policy in response to Title 5 regarding how exams have to apply to local GE patterns.
  - b. A summary of the changes is attached (see below).



#### 3. Meta Updates – Bryan Nicol

- a. The Honors Council now has a position in the workflow. The approval for the position is only for new honors courses to ensure that all colleges are notified when faculty propose a new honors course, regardless of where the course is offered.
- b. The representatives are:
  - i. James Bany at MVC
  - ii. Dan Hogan at RCC
  - iii. Courtney Buchanan at NOR
- c. Disciplines now appear on programs on the approvals page to allow for more filtering options.
- d. The crosslisting functionality is still pending. Bryan will follow up when there are updates.
- e. Meta has a new reporting template that is available. The benefit of moving to the new format is that updates to the CORs (such as the addition of new data elements to the COR) can be done more easily. The 'old' reporting format we are currently one can only have updates applied within Meta's development timeline, which is done once per month.
  - i. Based on the differences in the CORs, the committee agreed to remain on the 'old' reporting format.
  - ii. The committee asked if it is possible to only post GESLO titles in the SLO section, rather than the complete text, and if formatting rules can be applied to the COR as a whole as well. Bryan will ask the Meta representative at the next meeting.

#### 4. Business Administration ADT 2.0 Replacing 1.0 – Jeanne Howard

- a. The new Business ADT 2.0 was approved at all the colleges and there is some confusion about whether the 2.0 program is replacing the 1.0 program. In Moreno Valley's addendum and catalog, there was no note indicating that 2.0 would replace 1.0 as there were questions about whether the program would have to go through the discontinuance process and how we ensure catalog rights.
- b. Casandra Greene Was under the impression that the 2.0 program was a modification and that it did not need to go through discontinuance.
- c. Bryan Nicol If a student maintains catalog rights to the 1.0 program, they will be able to be awarded the program regardless of whether it is in the catalog and whether it is deactivated in COCI.
- d. Nick Franco -2.0 is a different program, but it is meant to replace the 1.0 version. There was meant to be an overlap for just this one year, but in the 22-23 catalog, we would only have the 2.0.
- e. Ann Pfeifle This raises a concern that we are circumventing the normal process. There is a Fire Service program at Moreno Valley, for example, that is being told they have to go through the discontinuation process, but there are two other programs that students are able to move to. This may be opening the door to inconsistency in our process.
- f. Kelly Douglass Did not like how 2.0 was 'modified' through this process, but



- was under the impression this was done because there was no other choice due to mandates from the State Chancellor's Office and the needs for student transfer.
- g. Brian Johnson We may need to be more flexible in what we consider to be program modifications.
- h. Casandra Greene Will the 1.0 program be listed in the 22-23 catalog?
  - i. The committee agreed that the 1.0 program would not be listed in the 22-23 catalog.

#### 5. Brown Act – Kelly Douglass

- a. There is a need for both clarity and unity around the provisions of the Brown Act, and we may need guidance from District Academic Senate. The numerous executive orders are creating confusion around the right to continue to have voting members teleconference to meetings through March of 2022. Received guidance from the former chair of the ASCCC regulations committee, however, that information needs to be verified.
- b. It appears that nothing precludes the general public from teleconferencing in to meetings, except for closed sessions, but after March there is a need for guidance on how Brown Act regulations apply to members. What are others hearing?
- c. Ann Pfeifle The new Moreno Valley Academic Senate President, Felipe Galicia, said that we should prepare to be back in person in April 2022. He also indicated that it appears as though the Chancellor and legal counsel were reviewing this.
- d. Kelly Douglass The faculty union president made a comment that we may not have General Counsel at the moment, but we need to know what the law is. The ASCCC also has not released any information.
- e. Ann Pfeifle If the goal is accessibility, teleconferencing has made the meetings more accessible. Historically, the meetings used to be teleconferenced regularly. If that wasn't legal, we can adjust ensure we are complying with the law, but we should allow teleconferencing if that is in alignment with the law.
- f. Brian Johnson Legally, are we able to teleconference for the next two years, or is it at the discretion of the committee? While Norco is planning to teleconference for March, after March we are preparing to meet in person.
- g. Ann Pfeifle This may be the safest bet unless someone has an exemption. Unless we get different information, it appears we can meet via Zoom in March.
