 - b. Kelly Douglass – Moving forward will the waiving of the Brown Act requirements for teleconferencing be a locally determined decision? Starting in January 2022, who is locally deciding if it is safe enough and whether or not we are under a particular order? Is this being decided committee by committee? Will the Academic Senate have rules?

- c. Ann Pfeifle – For years, the committees had teleconferenced when there were satellite offices and there was never an issue.
- d. Jeannie Kim – AB361 authorizes a local agency to not adhere to the teleconference guidelines when the body holds a meeting during a state of emergency. This has to be determined by local officials. Will investigate the answer.
- e. Brian Johnson – If the district is not using the emergency distance education approvals in the spring, then to be consistent with that we should be back to in person meetings.

Discussion Items

1. ILA Interdisciplinary Set Up – Kelly Douglass
 - a. Social Justice Studies (SJS) is a discipline that was approved with Interdisciplinary Studies as the minimum qualification. We have existing courses in interdisciplinary studies in both the ILA and MIL disciplines. The minimum qualifications handbook indicates there is also a basic skills Interdisciplinary Studies, which may apply to ILA-800, but for the other courses that are not basic skills is the assumption that anyone can teach any ILA course? This may not be true. Some disciplines may want to use ILA-5, but their disciplines have not been cross-disciplined into it.
 - b. The primary concern is if the interdisciplinary studies is being used appropriately across the disciplines.
 - c. Jennifer Floerke – Perhaps related to this is that Silvester Julienne from HR is receiving a variety of requests for FSAs for disciplines that do not yet exist within the district. This raises the question of equivalencies and what the process is for smaller disciplines that may consist of only one or two faculty. HR will also need guidance.
 - d. Ann Pfeifle – This may also be an issue particularly with smaller disciplines being able to decide strictly who gets to teach the course. SJS is interdisciplinary, and there are very few people who have degrees in Social Justice Studies. Faculty typically have degrees in Sociology.
 - e. Kelly Douglass – Which raises the question, would someone with an SJS degree be able to teach SJS here?
 - f. Jennifer Floerke – Interdisciplinary Studies is provided to allow for cases where it is locally determined that qualifications to teach a course exceed a single discipline. It can include any disciplines found in the master list.
 - g. Brian Johnson – Placing courses in disciplines is a 10+1 matter, so it would be under faculty purview.
 - h. Kelly Douglass – This may need to be discussed at Academic Standards.
 - i. The committee agreed to convene Academic Standards after the December 7th DCC meeting, and to ask at the November 30th College meeting for volunteers to serve as representatives. At the December Academic Standards meeting, the committee will also create a schedule to meet regularly in the spring.

2. Meta Updates – Bryan Nicol

- a. Meta has a new feature that will allow proposals to be created and launched when the current version has a status of Approved, when normally the system requires a proposal to have a status of Active. This will require that the search screen when launching a new proposal be updated.
- b. Meta has also nearly finished configuring the Honors Council step. The Honors Council approval will only be required on new courses, and will require a representative from each college to review the proposal. The step in the workflow will take place after the discipline/department level and before Tech Review.
- c. The committee agreed to move forward with both changes.
