Discussion Items

- 1. Addendum Criteria and Memo
 - a. The committee reviewed the January 2020 draft addendum memo and criteria.
 - b. **Question:** What impact does publishing new courses to the addendum have on scheduling and articulation?
 - i. Bryan Medina will develop a timeline with the AOs that outline the articulation submission and approval timelines and how they relate to publication to the addendum. Department Chairs can then use these timelines when planning publication to the addendum and scheduling.



2. Title 5 Updates – Torria Davis

- b. Interim Dean of Distance Education, Torria Davis, provided an overview of the Title 5 Updates along with recommendations on how to accommodate the changes within curriculum.
- c. The District has until May 2023 to accommodate the updates. The Distance Education Chairs have gone through the existing AP 2105 to make updates and will present the updates to the Academic Senate with a planned submission to the May Board of Trustees meeting.
- d. **Question:** While the changes make it clear that a separate DE addendum is not required and that the DE information can be listed in the Course Outline of Record, historically, there has some bias when it comes to DE delivery listed on the COR. Has there been any update from UC and CSU partners?
 - i. Torria Davis Unaware of any feedback.
 - ii. Kelly Douglass Maintaining a separate DE addendum may be the cautious way forward.
- e. Kelly Douglass One concern is the recommendation regarding the publication of course standards, specifically regarding how students will be informed. While faculty are the subject matter experts on the topic of the course, faculty have no control over the different systems that present the course modality and scheduling information at the time of registration. Students are frustrated that our existing systems do not properly display the modality information at the time of registration, but this is an administrative responsibility, not a faculty responsibility.
 - i. Torria Davis The Distance Education Chairs have also grappled with these concerns. As a part of this, the chairs developed updated language for the catalog that states that the student needs to consult with the instructor prior to the course starting, but putting the responsibility on the student is not an ideal solution.
- f. Steven Schmidt If there is an update needed to the DE form, what is the order of operations?
 - i. Kelly Douglass This committee would make edits, take the form to the DE committee for review, and then take the form to the Senate for final approval.

4. Common Course Numbering Survey – Susan Mills

- a. The State Chancellor's Office has sent a survey regarding common course numbering practices. The committee agreed to cancel the College Curriculum meeting on March 28 and instead hold a special workgroup meeting to complete the survey. Susan Mills will email the Chancellor's Office to request an extension on the March 29 deadline.
- b. Steven Schmidt will review the survey and answer the questions to the extent possible in preparation for the workgroup to review at the meeting.
- c. Kelly Douglass Regarding question 27 and the district's evaluation of common course numbering implementation, the California legislature has passed a law that is now a mandate from the State Chancellor's Office that we are required to enact. I am not interested in being their scape goat on this project nor do we want the State Chancellor's Office to be able to claim that they modeled their plan after RCCD, and now it doesn't work. The State Chancellor's Office needs to provide us with course numbers and should not be setting us up to be a workhorse for their mandate.
- d. Ann Pfeifle The State Chancellor's Office is pretending that we have a decision in this, but we don't.

5. Meta Updates – Bryan Medina

- a. There are still workflow issues with the Course Inclusion and Exclusion proposals, but Curriqunet is working towards a solution.
- b. Curriquent is anticipating loading the new user interface into the sandbox environment in late April with a move to production by the end of the year.
- c. Bryan will continue working with Meta to find a solution on the Intermediate Algebra and entry skill links issue.

Title 5 Changes (continued)

Recommended changes based on a review of the following documents:

- DE Addendum Standard Proposal
- DE Addendum Emergency Proposal
- Course Outline of Record for English 1A

Title 5 Changes (continued)

Changes to Section 55005(e):

- Publication of Course Standards
 - 1. All online and in-person synchronous meeting days/dates and times
 - 2. Any required asynchronous in-person activities
 - 3. Any required technology platforms, devices, and applications
 - 4. Any test or assessment proctoring requirements

DE Addendum and COR Recommendation: Consider adding a section labeled "Publication of Course Standards" where it is noted how students will be informed of the four items above.

Title 5 Changes (continued)

Changes to Section 55200:

- Definition and Application
 - · Adds "regular and substantive interaction"
 - Included the minimum federal requirements which include the types of technologies used for distance education
 - Added a definition of accessible in the context of distance education
 - Revised references in the "authorities cited" section:
 - Federal regulations
 - Americans with Disabilities Act

DE Addendum Recommendation: Consider changing section title to "Regular and Substantive Interactions" for consistency with update.

Title 5 Changes (continued)

Changes to Section 55204 (continued):

- Instructor Interaction
 - Substantive interaction includes teaching, learning and assessment consistent with the content and two of the following:
 - Direct Instruction
 - Accessing or providing feedback on coursework
 - Responding to questions
 - Facilitating group discussions
 - Other activities approved the institution or accreditation agency

COR Recommendation: While there is a method of instruction section, consider listing these five as examples for this (i.e. such as direction instruction, accessing or providing feedback, etcl.) to align with the federal and state regulations.

Title 5 Changes (continued)

Changes to Section 55204:

- Instructor Interaction
 - Aligned definition with the federal "regular and substantive interaction" criteria
 - Added that the course outline of record can be a resource to note courses that require RSI among students (separate DE Addendum not required)
 - Elaborated on substantive interaction, regular interaction, and asynchronous instructional time

No Changes Needed to the DE Addendum or COR. However, since a separate DE Addendum is no longer required, you may want to consider making the content of the DE Addendum a separate section within the Course Outline of Record to be completed as needed.

Title 5 Changes (continued)

Changes to Section 55206:

- Separate Course Approval
 - Both the course outline of record and the DE Addendum can be used to demonstrate compliance with regulations
 - Either the COR or DE Addendum must explain how course design and course materials are accessible to every student, including students with disabilities

Title 5 Changes (continued)

Changes to Section 55208:

- Faculty Selection and Workload
 - Added the federal requirement that distance education instructors must meet qualifications established by the accrediting agency
