#### **Action Items**

1. Curriculum Proposals

Curriculum proposals will be reviewed, discussed, and considered for forwarding to the College Curriculum Committees.

#### **Discussion Items and Public Comment**

- 1. Updating AOEs Ann Pfeifle
  - a. Ann Pfeifle Which discipline owns and maintains each of the AOEs? Last semester the committee discussed the topic, and there's a desire to also review the Communications



AOE as the degree no longer leads to the goal that was the original intent of the program. Additionally, having a modification proposed to the KIN AOE, as an example, without any input from KIN faculty seems odd.

- b. Kelly Douglass We are going to have more interdisciplinary programs in the future. Social Justice Studies is one example, which is has an ADT that has courses from a variety of disciplines as a part of it.
  - i. Recommendation: Similar to the honors council, have an interdisciplinary council that recommends changes to interdisciplinary programs like the AOEs. The council could be comprised of faculty from every discipline in the program, with the option for that discipline to opt in if they would like to participate. We could then ask Senate whether the council should be a voting body or advisory only.
- c. Kristen Gerdes There are 8 different Social Justice Studies ADTs. A Sharepoint site was created and faculty from each discipline were asked to join and participate. So far one meeting has taken place, but it has been successful so far.
- d. Ellen Brown-Drinkwater This could result in having 15 to 20 different disciplines for a given AOE.
  - i. Kelly Douglass Could be a reviewing body only that is opt in only with no vote, that would mean it is just an advisory committee.
- e. Brian Johnson Alternatively, the AOEs should be handled by the Curriculum Committee, Tech Review, and DCC. In the past, we would take General Education proposals at the beginning of fall, allow some time to have faculty members weigh in, agendize the items as information items or public comment, and then vote at the beginning of spring. This gives anyone who has an interest plenty of time to make a comment about a course being added to an AOE. This would also allow for a first and second reading by the curriculum committee before moving on to approval.
- f. Kelly Douglass Even though AOEs and ADTs are interdisciplinary and overlap, they have different goals and were assembled differently. Maybe the advisory council review would work for the ADTs that are interdisciplinary, especially because they are much narrower and follow a state driven curriculum model. Perhaps we could return to the first and second read model for the AOE. We can review the calendar to establish launch deadlines so approvals can be done at the end of the year.

#### 2. Curriculum Handbook Updates – Ann Pfeifle

- a. Steven Schmidt Some updates have been done to formatting, but with changes like Common Course Numbering and the new UI with Curriqunet coming forward, we have held off on making major updates to the handbook for now. Much of the information is still the same. However, this is still a spreadsheet available to help collect feedback on the handbook.
- 3. Tailoring Information in College Catalogs Ann Pfeifle
  - a. Ann Pfeifle In the area where the AOEs are listed, can we indicate which courses are specific to that college?
  - b. Bryan Medina proposed bolding the courses that are specific to that college in each catalog. The committee agreed that could be potential first step.
- 4. AB1111 Case Study Susan Mills
  - a. Susan Mills The RP Group has provided a copy of their first draft on RCCD's common course numbering.
  - b. The committee reviewed the draft and provided comment:
    - i. Concern regarding Section 3, paragraph 1 The use of the word "unofficial" is



- odd, and the help outlined in the paragraph is help that we would give to any of our colleagues, not just one single college. The paragraph can be struck in its entirety. Additionally, we should emphasize that common course numbering was always a part of the district and never had to be adopted.
- ii. Section 1, final paragraph: Are they talking about the differences in scope between Tech Review and the College Curriculum Committees? The review that's done by the librarians? This paragraph is unclear.
- c. Questions were raised by the RP Group seeking examples to certain situations including articulation differences across the colleges and the length of time it takes to approve courses in our curriculum approval process. The Articulation Officers may be able to provide the best answers regarding articulation differences, and the curriculum calendar may be able to provide the best answer regarding length of time.
- d. Jeanne Howard One example of a discrepancy is that ETS 1 is approved for CSUGE and IGETC for Ethnic Studies at NOR and RIV, but not yet at MOV. This has resulted in students enrolling into a course that is not yet approved for the Ethnic Studies areas of GE.
- e. Steven Schmidt requested that the Tech Review Committee have an additional opportunity to review the document before it is sent back to the RP Group.
- f. The committee agreed they would be willing to meet with the RP Group again for discussion, scheduled for a Thursday when District Academic Standards does not meet from 3pm-5pm.

### 5. AB1111 Common Course Numbering – Bryan Medina

- a. Common Course Numbering was briefly discussed at the Curriculum Institute and a
  public meeting was held last week by the task force workgroup. Updates included the
  following:
  - i. It appears common course numbering will not just require a common course number, but common course elements such as the title, description, SLOs, objectives, etc.
  - ii. The taskforce is hoping to finalize and release the public document and overall governance structure by the end of the year and to have any infrastructure needed in place by the legislated deadline next July.
  - iii. The State Chancellor's Office is seeking an extension for the implementation deadline, and will be proposing several waves of courses to be implemented through Fall 2027.
  - iv. Implementation funding should be released to the colleges sometime in the spring.
- b. Kelly Douglass Regarding the funding, that should go to help cover any overtime by curriculum specialists, IDSs, etc., and others who will be performing a lot of the front end implementation.
- c. Kelly Douglass We can begin telling colleagues that there will be no Curriqunet Freeze and that ASCCC and the CCCCO are seeking an extension, and that we are expecting more guidance in December. We want to avoid colleagues beginning to review courses without knowing what they actually need to change.
- d. Nick Sinigaglia Where can we raise our voices in resistance?
  - i. Kelly Douglass Most likely Senate Plenary.
  - ii. Steven Schmidt We can raise the topic of being concerned about what this means for your curriculum and that we need to express our opinions at the right venue. What does this mean for your independence, your voice, and your curriculum?
- e. Kelly Douglass At the Curriculum Institute we also learned that statewide, ETS faculty



do not have an agreement on what the ETS discipline is. Are they separate disciplines that have been housed under a single umbrella? How are minimum qualifications used in hiring? There could be similar problems if we are moving to a common curriculum and we should be allowed to keep the curriculum that we have developed here at RCCD.

- 6. Curriculum Periodic Review Guidelines/Requirements Bryan Medina
  - a. What should be communicated to faculty regarding the requirements of periodic review?
  - b. Brian Johnson Whenever the discipline moves through program review, they should also look at their courses and decide if they need updating. In theory, they should be looking at them every 4 to 5 years. Even if nothing has to be updated, most likely they will still need to update textbooks.
  - c. Kelly Douglass Both a minor modification and major modification reset the review timeline, and theoretically someone could do a minor mod for several years.
  - d. Kelly Douglass We are responding to multiple layers of regulations: local program review, UC transfer requirements, Title 5 requirements to review prerequisites and corequisites every 6 years, Title 5 requirements to review CTE courses every 2 years. If we ask that courses be updated at most every 5 years, we are ensuring that we are meeting the regulations.
  - e. Steven Schmidt Even if a course requires no changes, sending a major modification forward means it gets review by the curriculum committees.
- 7. Cooperative Work Experience Title 5 Updates Bryan Medina
  - a. Cooperative Work Experience has had Title 5 updates that will require a BP/AP update. What group should perform the review?
  - b. The committee agreed that District Academic Standards should perform the review, along with the work experience experts from the colleges (Ashley Etchison and her counterparts).
