Action Items

1. Curriculum Proposals

Discussion Items and Public Comment

1. Convening Councils for Interdisciplinary ADTs – Nick Sinigaglia
 - a. Moreno Valley is looking to develop the Environmental Science and Social Justice Studies ADTs. The timeline in the process documentation says the council should be convened in the fall to perform work in the spring. Is there an issue with convening the council now?

- i. Kelly Douglass – Would be comfortable overriding the timeline outlined in the process. If it can be handled locally on a different timeline, that seems fine. Feedback on how the process works would be great. Additionally, be aware that the program needs to be “owned” by a discipline for approvals in Curriquet.
 - ii. Nick Sinigaglia – Is that discipline required for program review and assessment?
 - iii. Kelly Douglass – We had discussed providing the process to assessment to recommend they use it. For program review, that would be the work of the council.
 2. Upper Division Course Outline Draft – Nick Sinigaglia
 - a. Charles Wilhite provided a draft of an upper division course he is developing for the fall. Does the committee have any feedback?
 - i. Kelly Douglass – Some of the SLOs sound like assignments. Also, the content seems generic. Compare to the JOU-150 Public Relations course, which is much more detailed. We should expect that same level of detail even if the ideas are more complex.
 - ii. Brian Johnson – Do upper division courses have lower division prerequisites?
 1. Nick Sinigaglia – Title 5 says it is possible.
 2. Kelly Douglass – It should have a limitation on enrollment so that only students in the baccalaureate program can enroll.
 - iii. Nick Sinigaglia – Do we want references to explicit skill sets or knowledge the course builds on?
 1. Kelly Douglass – This would be done in the entrance skills.
 - iv. Steven Schmidt – How do we train our committees to review upper division courses?
 1. Kelly Douglass – We should see if the State Chancellor’s Office has any resources for us. We would want to train the committee before these courses come forward.
 3. Curriquet Origination Permissions – Bryan Medina
 - a. Bryan Medina provided a report that compares user origination permissions to the full time faculty FSA lists provided by HRER.
 - b. The committee discussed that there is most likely a need for the chairs to discuss any clean up with the VPAAAs first, and to take it on a case-by-case basis. Some faculty would not understand that they are losing permissions, and others may not understand that the discipline work is their responsibility. No adjustment to user permissions will be made until the committee provides further direction.
 - c. Brian Johnson – Can any user be a co-contributor?
 - i. Bryan Medina – Yes. The originator can add any user as a co-contributor, and that contributor can have full access to the proposal.
 - d. Brian Johnson – We need to put more responsibility on the departments as well. If someone is creating a course, but they are not a part of the discipline, everyone can see that from the Curriquet notifications.
 - e. Bryan Medina – We have instances where faculty have created new disciplines and have written courses, but they do not have the FSA on their record. Should we hold future discipline creations at Tech Review until we have verification from HRER?
 - i. Nick Sinigaglia – This can be challenging if the college wants to hire faculty to create the courses. We would need the discipline to exist.

4. Curriqunet COR and Form Updates – Bryan Medina
 - a. The committee agreed that when displaying lecture units and lab units, the information should appear on the same line as the lecture hours or lab hours. The awarded units should be labeled “Total Units.”
 - b. In the course form, hours and units should be grouped by activity type (Lecture Hours followed by Lecture Units; Lab Hours followed by Lab Units).
5. Open Forum
 - a. Steven Schmidt – CORs are not showing entrance skill links when newly selected. Be sure to verify on the proposal form that the link was selected.
 - b. Kelly Douglass – An impact report for an ENGL class did not display the programs the course is associated with. Why is this?
 - i. Bryan Medina – You need to check the impact report for each version of the course. Bryan has submitted a ticket to see if the report can display the same information across all versions of the course.
 - c. Kelly Douglass – On an exclusion proposal, there was no impact report available.
 - i. Bryan Medina – This is correct. You can check the impact report on the course itself.
 - d. Kelly Douglass – In CCN, there is an ESL course in Phase 3 that is for transfer credit. It is not based on a C-ID, but there are ESL courses that other colleges have that are articulated as meeting the same requirements as ENGL-1A. ESL faculty would like to create a course now so that they are ready when the CCN template is released. Faculty took the ENGL-C1000 course elements and added a significant number of ESL elements to it. Is this considered as having significant overlap with ENGL-C1000? They have listed in the description that students cannot receive credit for both ENGL-C1000 and the ESL course. Is this appropriate? Do we know if there are specific rules that define credit restrictions like this?
 - i. Brian Johnson – ESL should get agreement from ENGL to place that in the description.
 1. Kelly Douglass – And the language would need to be added to the ENGL version of the course.
 - ii. Casandra Greene – If the courses are not cross-listed, they are not equivalent. Courses that have ENGL-C1000 as a prereq would not accept the ESL course. Is there a concern about unit bloat if students take both ENGL-C1000 and the ESL course? This would be 9 units in total.
 - iii. Kelly Douglass – If we remove that language, can we accept a course that has the same content as ENGL-C1000, but has an ESL component?
 - iv. Nick Franco – At Mt. SAC, their course description says you can only receive credit for one. We may need to look at other CCCs to see what they do.
 - v. Bryan Medina – If we say they are equivalent courses, this means in all program requirements, requisite requirements, and with the retake policy, both ENGL-C1000 and the ESL course will be the same.
 - vi. Nick Franco – In Assist for Mt. SAC, AMLA-1A is cross listed with ENGL-1AM.
 - vii. Brian Johnson – Are MAT-12 and PSY/SOC-48 equated?
 1. Bryan Medina – They are not. They are considered separate courses and students can take both.
 2. Casandra Greene – The TMCs and programs list all four courses,

PSY/SOC-48 and MAT-12/12H.

viii. Kelly Douglass – It's possible there is some benefit to students who want to take both.

e. Brian Johnson – Discussed work experience with the Norco committee. One concern is having courses with just one student in them. How do we handle that?

i. Casandra Greene – It's not part of a faculty load; it's considered overload. At Riverside, that's why we suggested an area specific work experience, like for BUS/MKT/RLE, etc. For Norco, if ELE, ELC, MAN, and DFT courses are already cross listed, it may be appropriate to have a single work experience course for that area.
