Action Items

1. Curriculum Proposals

Discussion Items and Public Comment

1. New Honors Courses and Programs – Bryan Medina
 - a. The committee confirmed that new honors courses that have an existing non-honors counterpart can be clerically added to programs once they are approved.
2. GESLO Update – Nick Sinigaglia
 - a. One of the GESLOs has been updated. Does this go to the Board for approval? Nick will e-mail the District Academic Senate President to see if it can be sent to the October Board Committee meeting.
 - b. The committee discussed that, once approved, the GESLO should be updated in Curriqunet as an update to all courses, both current and historical.

- c. The committee discussed that it may be good to notify the curriculum committee at their next meeting that the GESLO language has been updated.
3. Curriqunet – Steven Schmidt
- a. Under the attached files section, a bullet should be added under the required documentation to list the minutes report.
 - b. If someone listed as a co-contributor on an active proposal launches a modification and is now the originator, the form properties co-contributor section locks and cannot be modified. Bryan will notify Acadea.
 - c. The RCCD Curriculum website link on the cover tab needs to be updated.
 - d. For the rationale field, the guiding text should be updated to “Rationale for the proposal. Why is this course being created or modified?”
 - e. If a minor mod proposal has requisites linked to a historical class, we’ve seen instances of the entrance skill links disappearing. We may need to fix these on a case-by-case basis.
 - f. There appears to be an issue in the system where an error displays on a modification saying a course with that number already exists, even though there is no other in review or draft version of the course. Bryan has reported this to Acadea. You can bypass the error by temporarily changing the course number, launching the proposal, and then reverting the course number.
4. Curriculum Calendar – Cassandra Greene
- a. The SAAM impacted and CCN courses next year are going to result in a very large number of system updates that need to be done by the coordinators. Casandra estimates it will be about 2.5x as many as her previous highest workload.
 - b. Kelly Douglass – With this data, perhaps we can suggest alternative deadlines in the spring, although that may be extremely frustrating for faculty. Perhaps we can use the CCN funding to pay faculty to update their courses during the winter.
 - i. Nick Sinigaglia – Can CCN funding be used for SAAM updates?
 - ii. Casandra Greene – Any overtime for CCN must be documented and reported.
 - c. Nick Sinigaglia – When are CCN Phase 3 templates released?
 - i. Kelly Douglass – Hopefully early spring. Phase 2B could be done in early March if work is performed over the winter. We could potentially ask for the remaining CCN before the end of the spring term.
 - ii. Casandra Greene – If SAAM work could be performed over the winter, that would be more beneficial. CCN work can’t be done without the templates.
 - d. Kelly Douglass – Perhaps we bring this issue to the committees and see if they have any recommendations for possible solutions.
 - e. Nick Sinigaglia – Spoke with the VPAA at Moreno Valley and was told that the SAAM discussion ended with Eric Bishop saying that the District would absorb the cost. Is that our understanding? How many classes can we avoid addressing?
 - i. Kelly Douglass - Most likely courses that would not have to calculate to an exact increment of unit would be courses in COS, BCTC, Nursing, and other areas where there are accreditation requirements.
 - ii. Lijuan Zhai – Will check with Eric Bishop and VP McGowan. We are organizing a meeting to discuss how to implement the SAAM changes and discuss the different impacts.
 - f. Kelly Douglass – The PCAH says that you cannot award units in increments of less than .5 unless it is stated in the Board Policy. Our current BP does not say anything about this, so it would not be permitted.
 - g. Kelly Douglass – Faculty should be aware of the implications, but it is not the role of curriculum committees or chairs to take on problems of load or part time pay. However, these decisions should not be made solely by administration or solely by faculty.

5. Open Forum

- a. Nick Sinigaglia – Jeff Rhyne is working on a global studies certificate, with the goal of the other two colleges having an identical counterpart. Is it correct he needs an originator at each college?
 - i. Steven Schmidt – Correct.
 - ii. Nick Sinigaglia – Is the certificate subject to the inter-disciplinary degree approval process?
 - 1. Kelly Douglass – Perhaps not. That policy is only for degrees. Perhaps we can note in Curriqunet which discipline houses the certificate, but that it may change depending on the Study Abroad Coordinator.
 - iii. Nick Sinigaglia – Jeff wants the courses to be identical, but not every college offers every certificate. Is there any kind of best practice policy?
 - 1. Kelly Douglass – Would recommend it be as expansive across the district, because which classes are offered via Study Aboard is not usually linked to any specific college.
 - iv. Jeff Rhyne – The courses in the certificate have a global/international focus themselves, and are not courses that have to be offered in study abroad. The study abroad courses would be a separate category.
 - 1. Nick Sinigaglia – Students don't have to be a part of study abroad?
 - 2. Jeff – Correct.
 - 3. Nick Sinigaglia – How do we do that?
 - 4. Casandra Greene – There is language that states they can complete the certificate without participating in Study Abroad, or can use a course they take during Study Abroad to fulfill a part of the certificate.
 - v. Kelly Douglass – Once the paper work is complete, it can be sent to the faculty counterparts at the other colleges.
