MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

RIVERSIDE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

AND

CALIFORNIA SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION AND ITS CHAPTER 535

'Out-of-Classification Assignments Timeline Extension, 2022'

This memorandum is agreed between the Riverside Community College District (District) and the California School Employees Association and its Chapter 535 (together "CSEA") concerning Article XVI – Assignment of Unit Members, Section B, the timelines pertaining to out of classification assignments.

Recitals:

The Parties acknowledge that the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) requires out-of-class assignments not exceed 960 hours when the assignment is to provide coverage for a vacancy in recruitment; and not to exceed eighteen (18) months where no recruitment exists. (Article XVI – Assignment of Unit Members, Section B, p. 36).

Acknowledging some out-of-class assignments have exceeded these timelines, sometimes for a significant period of time.

The parties acknowledge that it will begin enforcing the out of classification assignment timelines contained in Article XVI, Assignment of Unit Members, Section B.

As a result of the Parties' negotiations over this topic, CSEA and the District have agreed to the following:

- 1. Unit members will only be assigned out-of-class (OOC) assignments for classifications listed in Article I RECOGNITION.
- 2. Unit members currently working out-of-class (OOC) assignments which have exceeded eighteen (18) months as of February 16, 2022, shall have their OOC assignment timelines extended until June 30, 2023.
- 3. Unit members currently working OOC assignment which will reach the eighteen (18) month timeline between February 17, 2022, and June 30, 2023, shall have their OOC assignment timelines extended until June 30, 2023.
- 4. Unit members currently working OOC assignment that began after February 16, 2022, shall continue to work their out-of-class assignments until the completion of the eighteen (18) months, unless a vacancy is created and recruited, or the unit member is filling an assignment for a unit member out on a protected leave (Article XVI, Section B).
- 5. All out-of-classification assignments shall therefore cease on or before June 30, 2023, or the completion of the initial eighteen (18) months assignment, unless an extension or alternative solution is otherwise negotiated between the District and CSEA.
- 6. Such extensions to the OOC assignment timelines shall not impact the original start date of the unit member's OOC assignment.
- 7. Appendix A is a list of unit members whose current OOC assignments will be extended by this MOU. The Parties agree to immediately begin negotiations to permanently resolve all current OOC assignments that are noncompliant with Article XVI, Section B.
- 8. This Agreement is in no way intended, and shall in no way be construed, to restrict or waive rights guaranteed to CSEA under California Government Code in this or any other matter, now or in the future.
