# WHY THIS TOPIC?

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- Uncertainty of federal funding, including real and potential loss of existing funding
- Need to diversify funding
- Not all funding needs meet the definition of a program
- Project Directors requested this topic

# ESTABLISHING THE CORE PROGRAM

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- The focus is not new programming; but rather enhancements or additions to existing programming
- What is a Core Program?
  - Institutionalized by the College/District;
  - Included in the General Fund OR Supported by a long standing categorical or grant program
  - Does not need operating funds to sustain the program
  - Serves as the foundation upon which new programming can build
  - Seeks additional funding to enhance existing services
  - Led by a Program Director or Manager or Faculty Chair or Dean

- Student Support Services
- EOPS
- Guardian Scholars
- Engagement Centers
- Veterans Resource Center
- Instructional Programs

# IDENTIFYING NEEDS

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- Benefits of a Core Program
  - Lots of data readily available
    - Understanding where the gaps exist
  - Program Review or External Evaluation exists
- Use data and evaluation findings to identify what program stakeholders need
- Align needs with program goals and objectives
  - Do not create new goals and objectives



# OUTLINING PROGRAMMING

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- Not all programming is created equal
- Targeted programming for small requests should be:
  - Time limited
  - Not essential to the Core Program
  - Self-contained
  - Able to be quickly and easily added to the Core Program
  - Terminable

## **Common Types of Project Add-Ons**

- Mental Health Counseling
- Basic Needs Assistance (food, housing, child care, transportation, etc.)
- Case Management
- Professional Development
- Field Trips
- Speaker Series
- Research Experiences

# DEVELOPING THE BUDGET

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- Costs Amenable to Project Requests

- Hourly, Temporary Employees
- Faculty Special Project Requests
- Consulting Services/Professional Services, such as mental health counseling
- Travel
- Direct Aid
- Materials and Supplies

- Costs that Should be Avoided

- Salary and Benefits for New Employees
- Salary and Benefits for Existing Employees
  - Release Time is OK
  - Overtime is OK depending on program
- Indirect Costs
  - Budgets are tend to be small

# FINDING POTENTIAL SOURCES OF FUNDING

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- Public Grants
  - Federal: Current Status - Uncertain
  - State
    - Health Careers Exploration Program (HCAI)
    - CalHumanities (suspended due to federal uncertainty)
  - Local
- Private Grants

- Private Funding
  - Generally much smaller award amounts
    - \$5,000 to \$100,000
  - 12 to 24 month award periods
  - Highly competitive
  - Existing relationship with funder helpful
  - Direct alignment with funder's mission, goals, and strategic priorities necessary
  - Less flexibility
  - Impact and Innovation are important

# WORKING WITH THE GRANT TEAM

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- Help us help you!!
  - Send us your projects – one page is sufficient
    - Description of project
    - Target population
    - Amount of money needed
  - Request a meeting with us
    - Project development
    - Budget development
    - Brainstorming
- Share your external partners with us so we can do some prospect researching



# WORKING WITH THE GRANT TEAM

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- Reach out to us early in the process
  - It can take 6 to 12 months to receive a grant award
- Let us know when you submit a request on your own
  - Each college has a grant development and submission process – President approval is required
  - Critical to coordinate submissions across the District, within the colleges, and with the Foundation
  - We also track all requests and report out on them
