Ben Clark is a partnership with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department and numerous other agencies such as Cal Fire. Therefore, we do not have total say over what happens. In order for us to continue we must work together for the overall benefit of the community.

Trustee Blumenthal clarified that the majority of the cadets going through the program are considered employees of the Sheriff's department.

Trustee Vackar noted that as we begin to work with

employers in the region on apprenticeship programs, we may experience additional partnerships that will require unique circumstances and agreements.


Motion passed. (5 ayes)
