What is your student responsibility in regards to high school articulation?

- 1. Complete the college admission application
- 2. Create a student account in CATEMA to add your high school teacher and class period for the articulated course
- 3. Fulfill the minimum grade requirements for the high school articulated credit to be awarded by passing the class with a C or better first semester and B or better for one-year courses

*Final grade for second semester(for one-year courses) is not cumulative

Checklist for completing the Admission Application

Before beginning the application, gather the following information to successfully complete the admission application:

- ✓ Full legal name
- ✓ Date of birth
- ✓ Permanent Home/Mailing Address
- ✓ Personal Email Address (do not use your high school or parent email)
- ✓ Telephone Number
- ✓ Parent Guardian information: First Name, Last Name, educational status and contact information
- ✓ Social Security Number (not needed for DREAM ACT students)
- ✓ Lawful Permanent Residents: Registration Number, Issue and Expiration Date

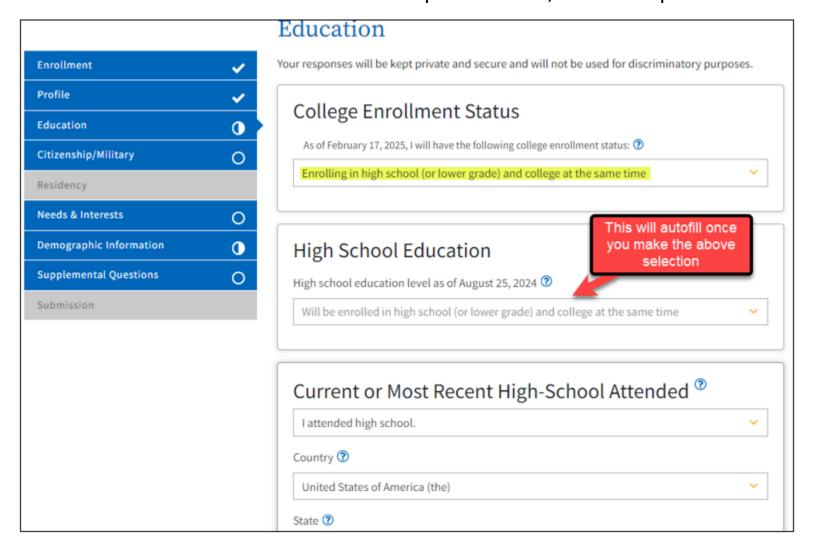


9th-11th Grade students select the options below





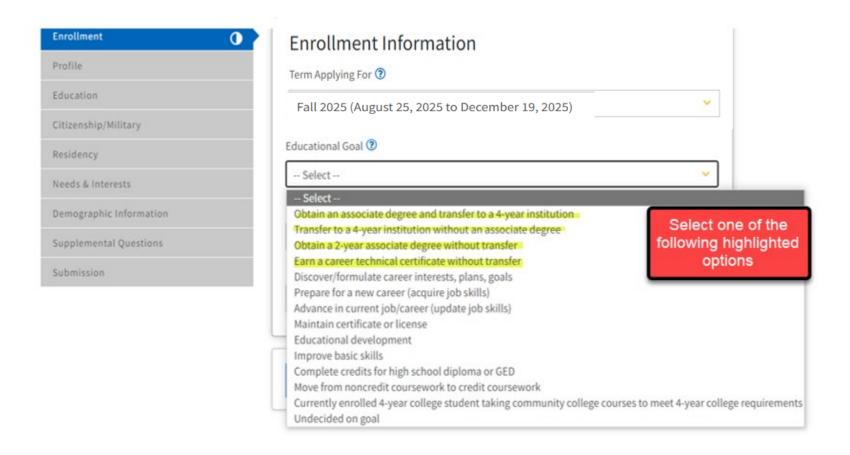

If you previously logged into MyPortal and established a password, it has not changed.
