About Measure CC

- Passed by voters in November 2024
- \$954M community investment for:
 - **New facilities** at MVC, BCTC, NC, and RCC
 - Renovation and/or demolition of RCCD's oldest buildings
 - **New facilities** in Corona and Jurupa Valley
 - Upgrades to modernize classrooms and labs
 - Allows local projects to pursue matching state funding



How this Bond Benefits the Community

- This investment in RCCD will pay huge dividends toward the economic vitality of this region.
- We will have a more educated workforce that is prepared for the growth and opportunities that are coming.
- More people from the diverse populations living in this area will have access to a higher education than ever before - ensuring social justice and equity.
- Facilitates the emergence from poverty to prosperity for those who have traditionally been disadvantaged.
- It will allow our colleges to upgrade career programs and partnerships with local employers.

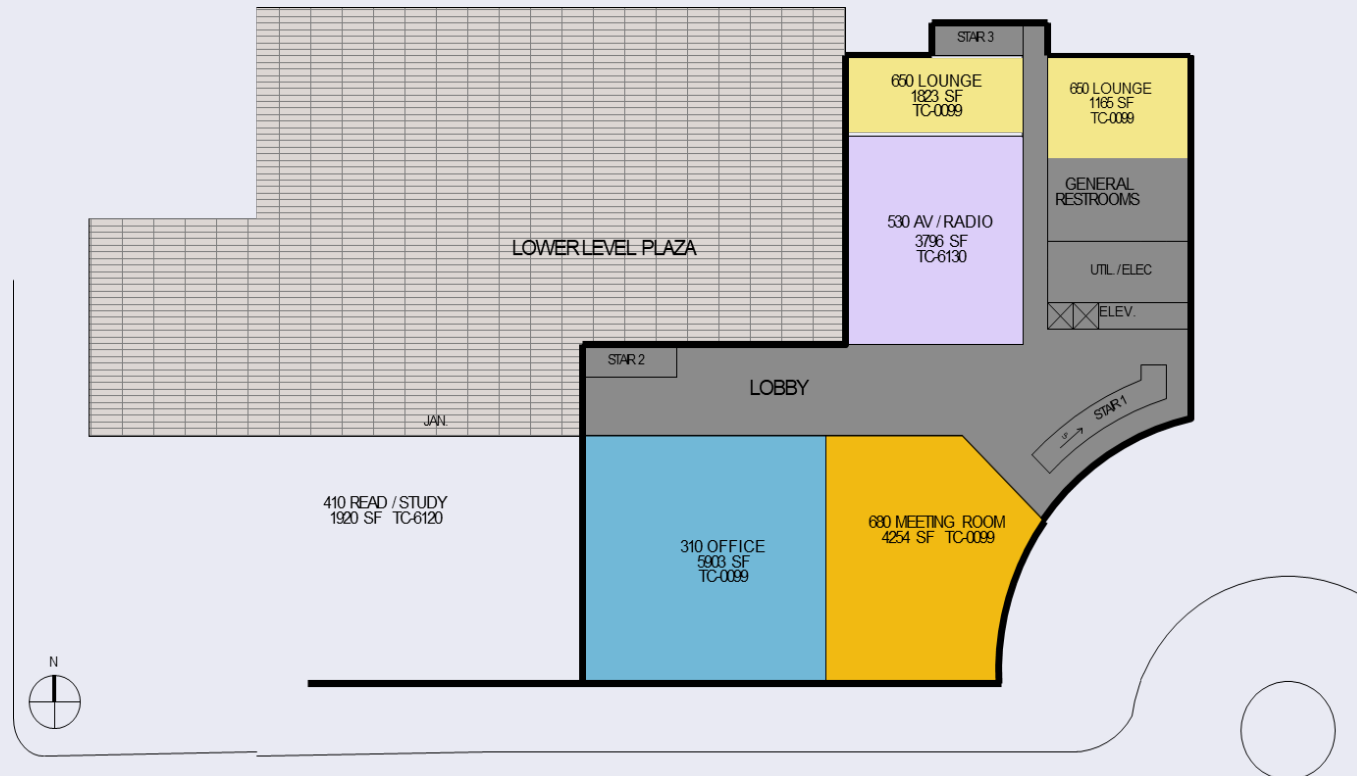

Library Learning Resource Center

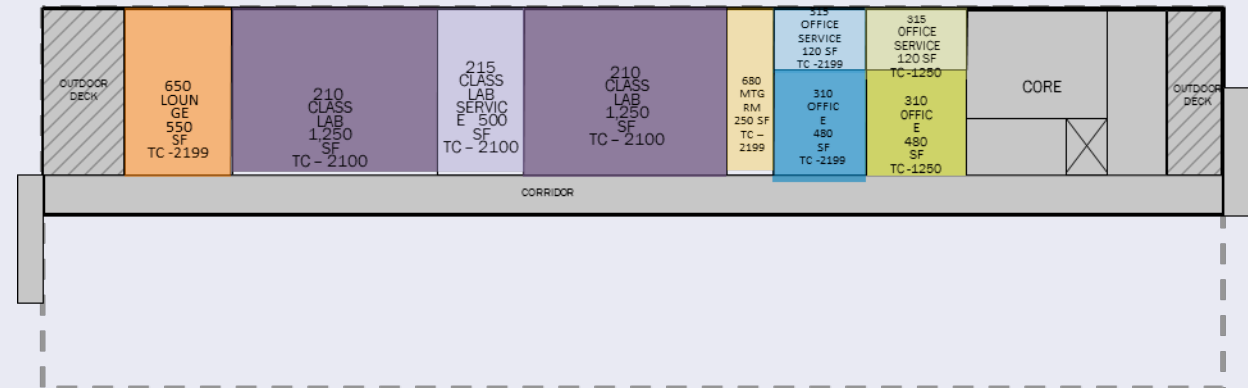
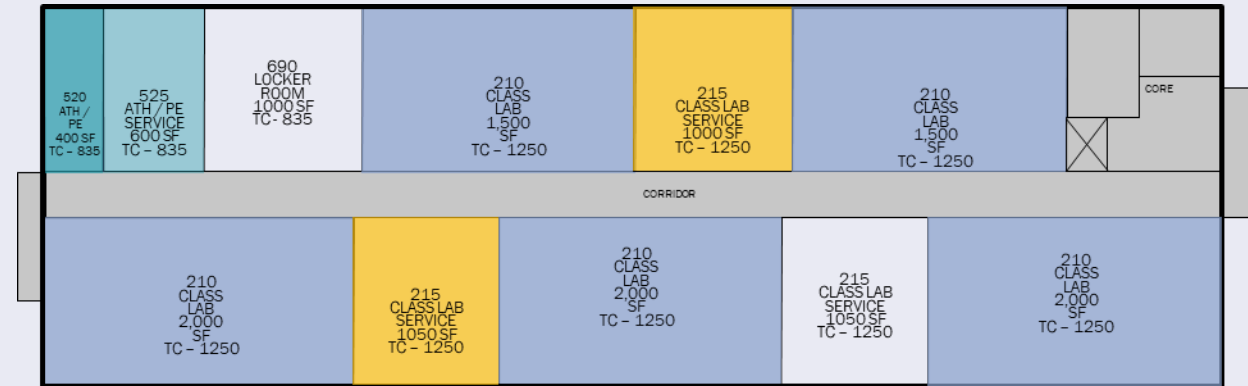

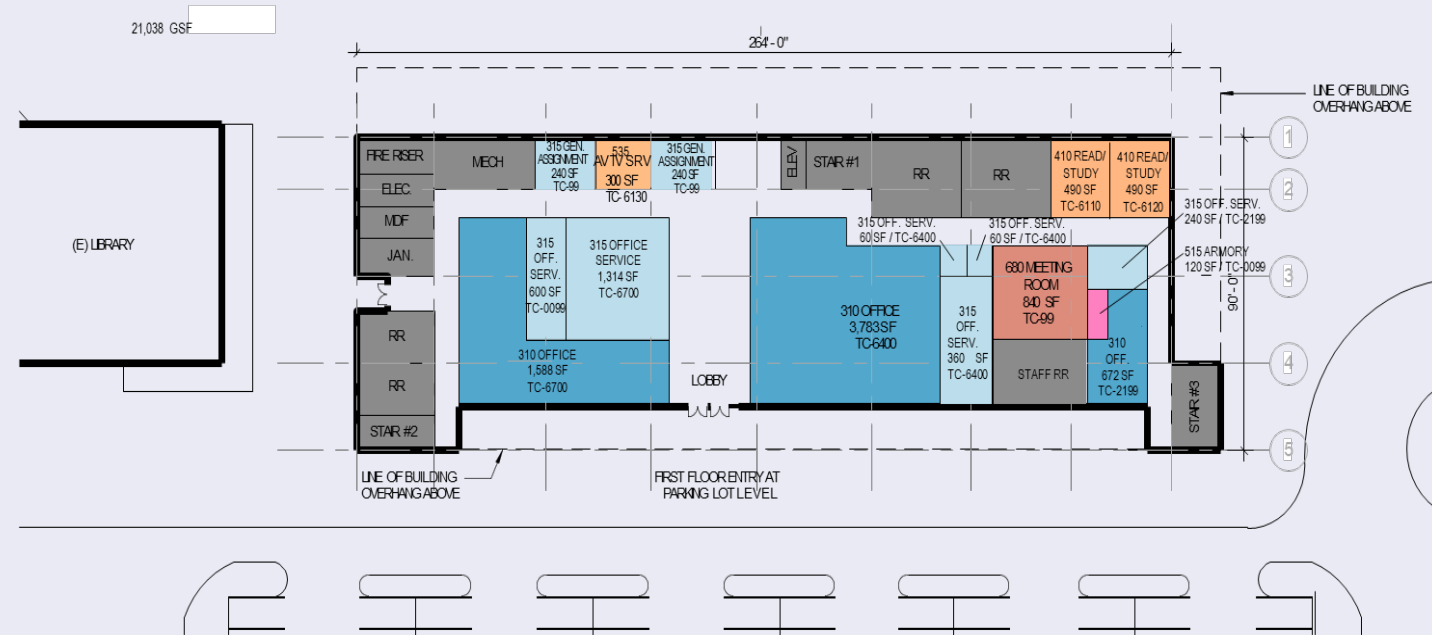

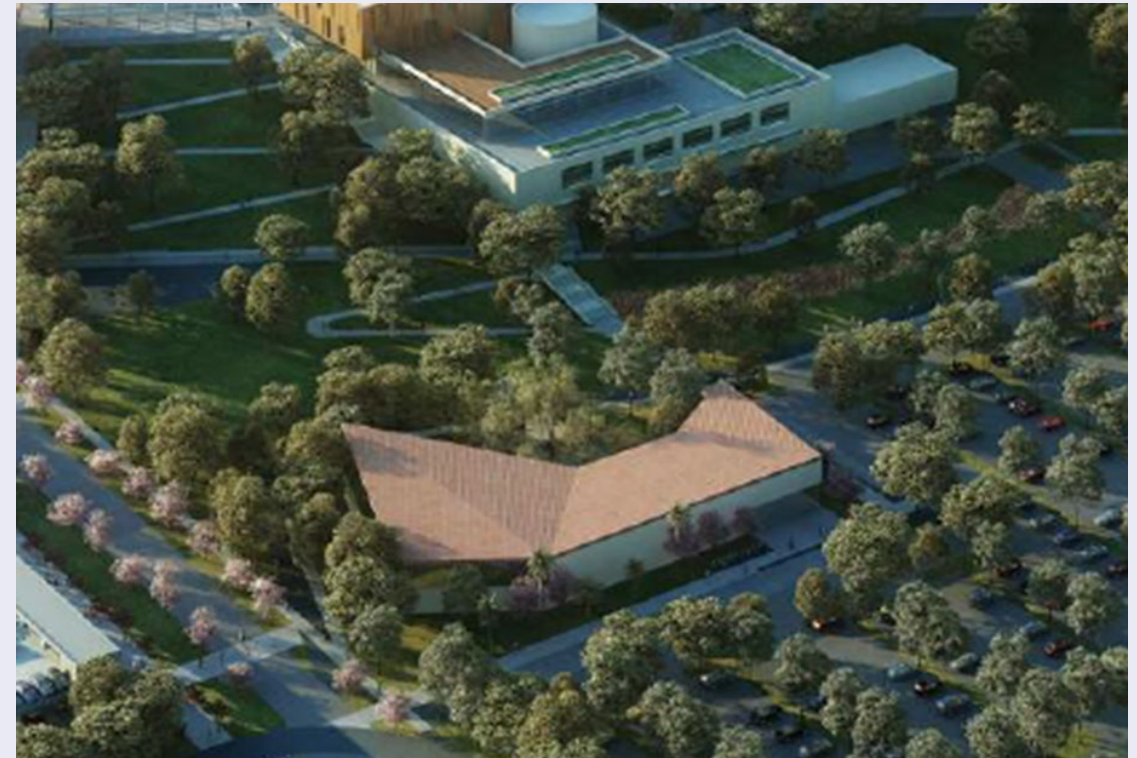

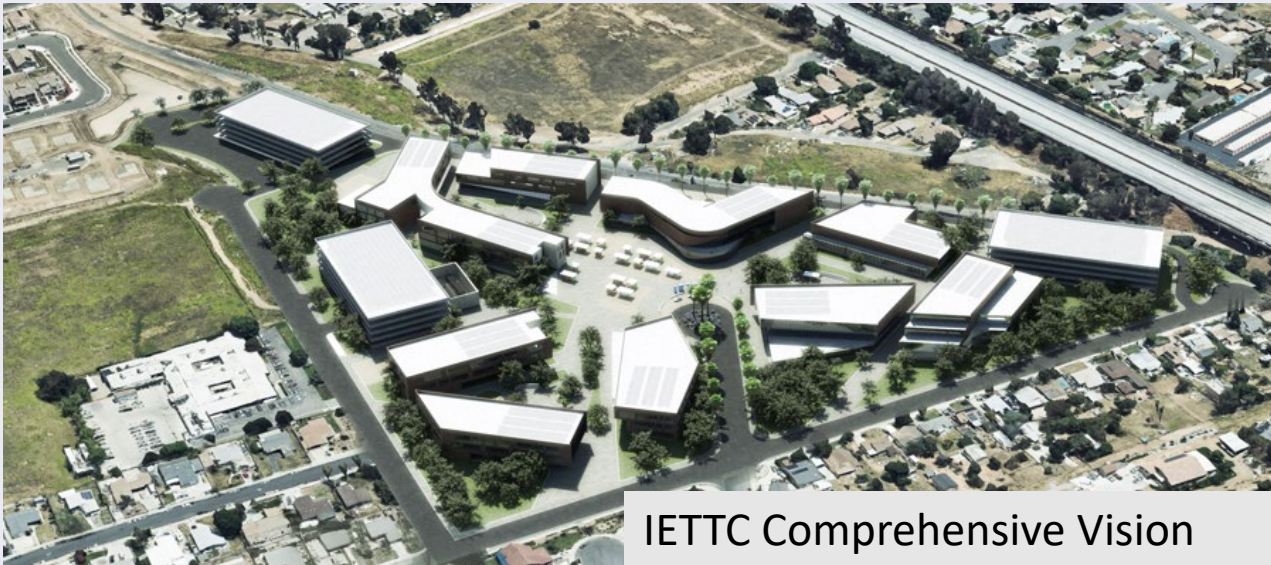
Locally Funded Measure CC Projects

- **Corona Education Center** — approximately 72,000 GSF

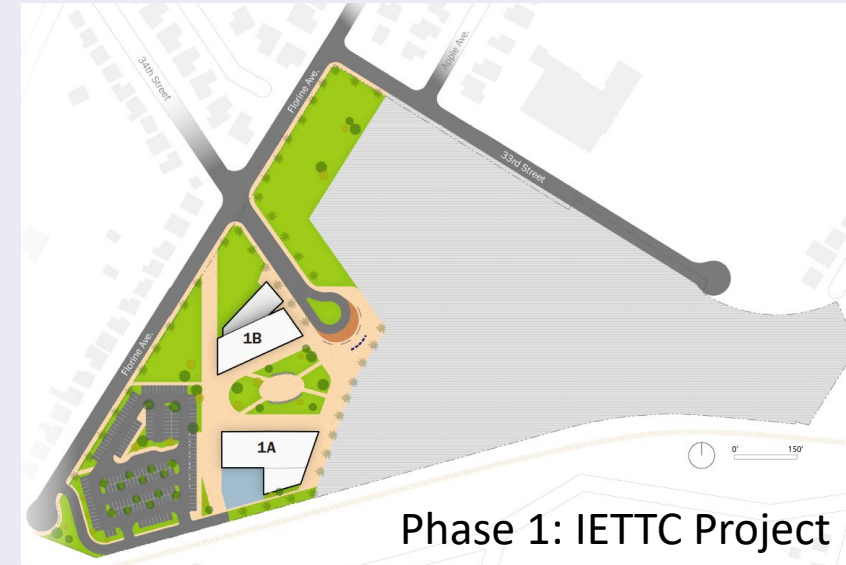


Inland Empire Technical Trade Center

- Enrollment target 400 FTES – about 1,200 Students
- Site Development/Infrastructure & Two CTE Buildings
- Budget for Phase 1: \$180M



IETTC Comprehensive Vision

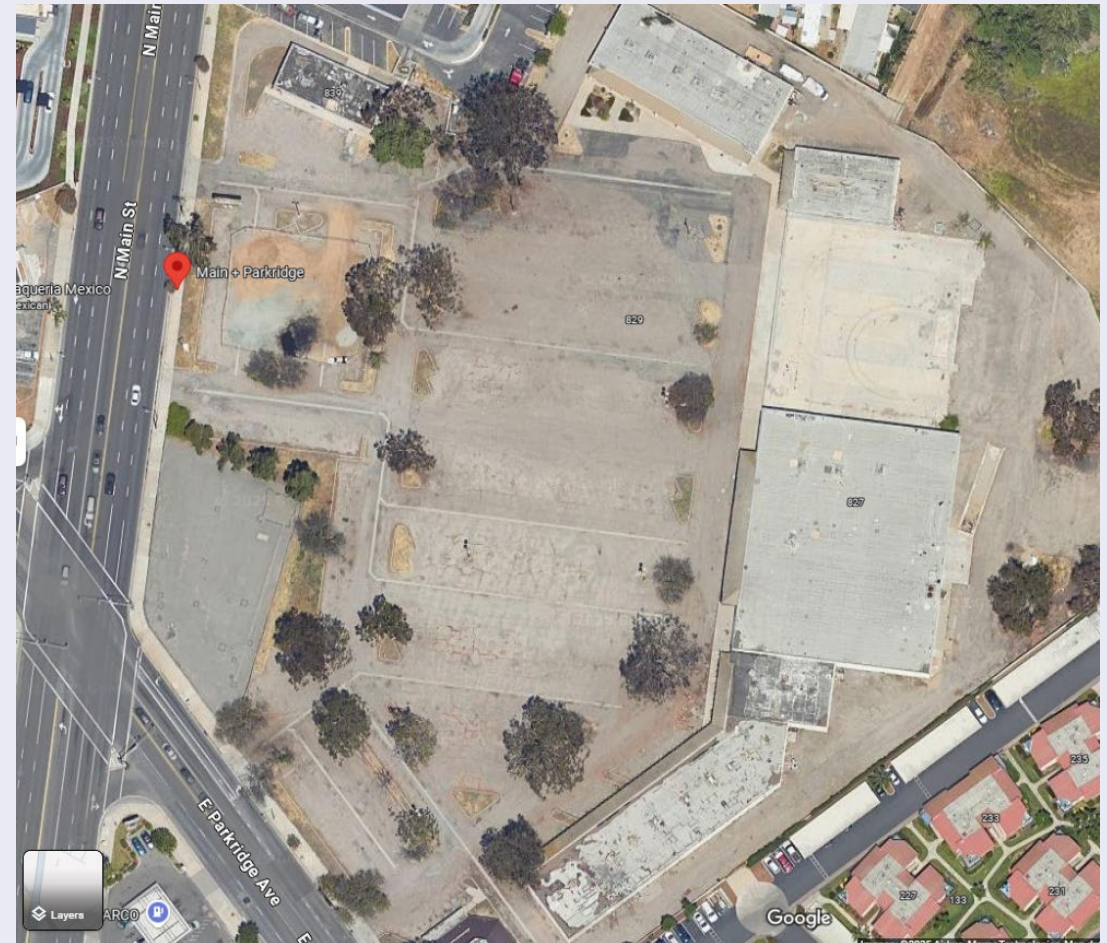


Phase 1: IETTC Project



Corona Education Center

- Land Acquisition/Site Demolition

- Budget: \$160M (including land acquisition)





Future Projects Needing State Approval

- **Applied Technology (ATEC) at RCC, FY 2026-27** — 134,000 GSF
- **STEM Building at MVC, for FY 2027-28** — approximately 72,000 GSF



Oversight

- Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC)
 - Reviews Measure C/CC expenditure reports and informs the public about the District's use of bond proceeds.
 - Provides annual reports to the RCCD Board of Trustees and the public.
- RCCD Board of Trustees
- Measure CC requires public disclosure of all spending, independent annual financial and performance audits, and must follow designated project list.
- All Measure CC funds will be used for our local community colleges and cannot be taken by county, state or federal governments.
