Senate Report

September 16, 2019

Approximately 96% of active courses have assessment results for **at least one course SLO**. ACCJC required the College to be at 100% by fall 2016. There are 26 active courses **without ANY** assessment results in Nuventive Improve (see the attached list). In addition, only 14 out of 46 disciplines have assessed all SLOs in the last four years. Please ask the faculty to help the College achieve our goal of **ongoing assessment of 100% of our courses** by assessing **all course SLOs every four years**. [In Nuventive Improve, a red X (instead of a green check) next to a course indicates that there are one or more SLOs that need to be assessed.]

The following reports (in **draft** form) are also part of this senate report:

1. Inactive Course Lists - As of September 11, 2019, there are 201 courses designated as inactive in Nuventive (TracDat):
 - a. One list is alphabetical. The other list is separated into three categories:
 - i. Inactive courses (92) - Most of these courses have not been taught in several years.
 - ii. New courses (103) - Courses added to the catalog in the last three years that have not yet been taught.
 - iii. Cross-Listed Course (6) - Courses that are regularly offered by another discipline.

Please note: Courses being taught this fall have not yet been transferred to discipline units.
2. General Education Course List as of September 12, 2019 – This list indicates the following:
 - a. General education courses that do **NOT** have any links to General Education SLOs on the related Course Outline of Record (COR).
 - b. General education courses that have SLOs in Nuventive that do NOT match the current COR.
 - c. General education courses that are currently inactive.
3. General Education Student Learning Outcomes and related SLOs
4. General Education Student Learning Outcomes and related SLO Assessments

The Moreno Valley Assessment Committee's ongoing tasks include:

1. Following up on Programs in Nuventive with no mapping data or with incomplete mapping data [mapping Program Learning Outcomes (PLOs) to Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs)]. In addition, committee members are discussing with their departments/disciplines methods for directly assessing PLOs not covered by SLO assessments.
2. Discussing with their departments/disciplines methods for assessing General Education SLOs, including designing assessment tools that assess **both** the course SLOs and the related General Education SLOs.
3. Discussing with their departments/disciplines suggestions for improving the **quality** of assessment reporting.
