## Student Services - Educational Search

**Mission Statement:** The Educational Talent Search program is part of the federal TRIO programs and is one of four TRIO Programs at Moreno Valley College. ETS identifies and assists individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds who have the potential to succeed in higher education. The goal of Talent Search is to increase the number of youth from disadvantaged backgrounds who complete high school and enroll in and complete their post-secondary education.

The program publicizes the availability of financial aid and assists participants with the post-secondary application process. Talent Search also encourages persons who have not completed education programs at the secondary or post-secondary level to enter or reenter and complete post-secondary education.

**Highlights and Accomplishments:** : The total number of students served in your program/department - 500

The number of students who completed degrees/certificates in your program/department

The primary target group for ETS is middle school and high school students. Since we were completing our first cycle, we have yet had any students entering college. We are currently still in our 2nd year. We will not report on college degree enrollment and completion rates until 2020.

The number of faculty and staff in your program/department - Initiatives and goals accomplished

Currently, ETS is staffed by a Director who is split with other TRIO Programs. We are still trying to get approval for the position description of TRIO Outreach Specialist. This proposed position is a modification of the Outreach Specialist position descriptions for Upward Bound and Upward Bound Math and Science.

We currently have 4 Grant Facilitators who work part time to service the 6 schools for the program. When we initially wrote the grant, we had 5 schools (Valley View HS, Vista del Lago HS, Badger Springs MS, Mountain View MS, and Landmark MS).

**Major Developments and Changes:** After the first cycle, approximately 20 students transferred to Riverside County Education Academy which was not in the target school district. So that we could continue servicing the students who would have otherwise not have been able to continue the program, I obtained permission from the ETS Program Officers from the US Department of Education to add RCEA as a target school site.

it is critical that the new position be approved so that we can hire full time for this program so that we can meet the objectives of the program. The request and necessary supporting documents have been submitted multiple times over the past two years.

In spite of these challenges, we were able to have some of the ETS students participate in a College and Career Trip of Northern California schools and professional sites. We collaborated with UB and UBMS which allowed us to leverage the program's resources.
