**Mission Statement:** Middle College High School Program, made possible through the partnership between Moreno Valley College, Moreno Valley Unified School District and Val Verde Unified School District, fosters a supportive academic environment for Middle College students, with the goal of providing early development of college experience and leading them in their educational endeavors.

### Annual Updates

#### 2017 - 2018

**Highlights and Accomplishments:** For the 2018-19 academic year in the fall we had 181 students and in the spring 173. 31 (38.75%) out of 80 seniors were on track to complete one to three associate degrees. 78 (97.5%) seniors reported that they were planning to continue their education after high school graduation. 1 (1.25%) senior reported that they were enlisting in the military after high school graduation. 1 (1.25%) senior reported that they were not going to continue their education after high school graduation. 2 (2.5%) seniors did not meet high school graduation requirements at the end of the spring semester and had to enroll in summer school.

Within the department we have three high school teachers, one high school counselor and Administrative Assistant I, and the program director.

**Major Developments and Changes:** This year we started with 181 participants and ended with 173, a 95.5% program completion rate. Several students decided to return back to their high school and a couple were dismissed from the program for poor grades. From the 80 seniors who completed the program, two did not meet their high school graduation requirements at the end of the spring semester and had to enroll in summer school. We also had several students who did not finish well their spring semester. Additional support and advising will be provided for students during the spring semester.
