

# RIVERSIDE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT INLAND EMPIRE TECHNICAL TRADE CENTER (IETTC) FACT SHEET

As one of the few technical training facilities in the region, the new Inland Empire Technical Trade Center (IETTC) will provide hands-on, industry standard technical training and paid apprenticeships to grow the next generation of skilled talent in stable, well-paying careers. This project will improve economic opportunities for families across the City of Jurupa Valley and the greater Inland Empire, attract new businesses, and fill high-demand positions for local employers.

The IETTC aligns with several goals and policies in Jurupa Valley's General Plan (2017), including economic development and workforce training to strengthen the local economy, land uses that support community-serving uses and educational facilities, and healthy communities that expand access to educational and employment opportunities that improve quality of life.

## WHAT PROGRAMS WILL THE IETTC INCLUDE?

Job-training programs will align with local workforce needs, offering pathways in skilled trades, health care, agriculture, and entrepreneurship. Proposed programs range from HVAC, electrical, solar, carpentry, and diesel/EV mechanics to health roles like nursing assistants and home health aides, with additional opportunities in landscape management, hospitality, tourism, and small business development.

## WHO IS INVOLVED?

IETTC will be developed by the RCCD and will support educational programs offered and operated by Riverside City College (RCC).

## HOW CAN I FIND OUT MORE?

Engagement meetings will be held at **Rubidoux High School - Concert Hall** located at 4250 Opal St, Jurupa Valley, CA 92509, on **Tuesday, April 14, 2026**, and **Thursday, April 16, 2026**, from **5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.**

Residents, neighbors, nearby businesses, potential students, local community organizations, local education partners, workforce and trade partners, public agency representatives, and elected officials and staff are encouraged to attend.

## WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Building construction is scheduled to begin **November 2028** and **complete in April 2031**. Construction impacts may include:

- **Traffic:** Temporary Lane closures and increased truck traffic near Florine Avenue and 33rd Street during grading and utility connections.
- **Noise:** Typical construction noise during daytime hours; no overnight work planned.
- **Lighting:** Security and work lighting limited to construction zones; shielded to reduce glare on adjacent properties.
- **Operational Considerations:** All work contained on-site except utility tie-ins; staging areas planned to minimize disruption to surrounding streets
