

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The National Science Foundation (NSF) Scholarships in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (S-STEM) program addresses the need for a high quality STEM workforce in STEM disciplines supported by the program and for the increased success of low-income academically talented students with demonstrated financial need who are pursuing associate, baccalaureate, or graduate degrees in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- 1. Must be a legal resident or US citizen.
- 2. Must be a current full time student in the Science, Technology, Engineering, Math disciplines.
- 3. Must complete at least 1 semester of course work.
- 4. Must be on track to transfer to a university.
- 5. Must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 6. Must provide a current Financial Aid Award letter that states aid qualification due to low income and/or financial hardship.
