JOB TITLE: Instructional Media Technician

BASIC FUNCTION: Under the supervision of the area Manager, responsible for coordinating setup and operation of audiovisual, television and computer-based media for classrooms, libraries and special events; television operations, including KRCC Channel 25 cable Television, a satellite down linking facility and video conferencing system; production of educational/promotional/administrative media materials and programs; technical maintenance.

PROVIDES WORK OR LEAD DIRECTION TO: Not applicable – no permanent full-time staff to supervise.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

- 1. Produces, directs, scripts, records, mixes, edits, and duplicates audio and video productions for districtwide educational/promotional media presentations.
- 2. Edits script in pre-production scripting phase to ensure narration is in step with the stated goals of the production; resolves unexpected production problems during shoots; and during post-production editing phase makes decisions to get the program's point efficiently across to the target audience.
- 3. Schedules and maintains the IMC's Multi Media Production areas including Audio/Video Editing Suites and Video Studio.
- 4. Organizes and maintains the IMC's Production/Stock Tape Storage Room where production/telecourse masters and archival footage are housed.
- 5. Records, duplicates, repairs, and distributes RCCD's Telecourse collection for the District's two cable stations (KRCC Riverside & Moreno Valley) and three campus libraries (Riverside, Moreno Valley, and Norco).
- 6. Assists with the day-to-day operation of the Instructional Media Center/Media Distribution Center including satellite teleconferences, videoconferences, equipment delivery, set up, and break down.
- 7. Assists with the programming and operation of RCCD's cable station (KRCC).
- 8. Participates in District-provided in-service training programs.
- 9. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty, and the public.
- 10. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.

EDUCATION: An associate degree from an accredited institution is required.

EXPERIENCE: At least two years of closely related experience in production and/or broadcasting of media materials and the operation and maintenance of media equipment are required.
