JOB TITLE: Instructional Production Specialist

BASIC FUNCTION: Under the supervision of the Dean, Technology and Learning Resources, is responsible for performing setup and operation of audiovisual media for classrooms, library and special events; video conferencing system; production of educational/promotional/administrative media materials and programs; and technical maintenance.

PROVIDES WORK OR LEAD DIRECTION TO: Not applicable – no permanent full-time staff to supervise.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

- 1. Produces, directs, scripts, records, mixes, edits and duplicates audio and video productions for collegewide educational/promotional media presentations.
- 2. Edits script in pre-production scripting phase to ensure narration is in step with the stated goals of the production; resolves unexpected production problems during shoots; and during post-production editing phase makes decisions to get the program's point efficiently across to the target audience.
- 3. Schedules and maintains IMC's Multi Media Production including Audio/Video Editing Suites and equipment.
- 4. Performs video production from concept to post production.
- 5. Ability to operate a variety of multi-media equipment to include, computers, scanners, digital cameras, video cameras, NLE and/or Linear editing system, drawing tablets and printers.
- 6. Assists with the day-to-day operation of the Instructional media Center including satellite teleconferences, videoconferences, equipment delivery, set up, and break down.
- 7. Establishes project schedules to ensure on-time completion.
- 8. provides scheduled workshops and training to staff and faculty on new and existing audiovisual media equipment.
- 9. Conceptualizes art work for various multimedia projects for Academic Departments and ensures that the materials created coincide with either lesson material or other needs of the instrutors.
- 10. Participates in District-provided in-service training programs.
- 11. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty, and the public.
- 12. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.

EDUCATION: A bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with major coursework in video production and/or computer graphics is preferred.

EXPERIENCE: Three years of directly related experience in video production/computer graphics is required.

LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS: None

KNOWLEDGE OF: Video production, visual presentations and advanced knowledge in computer graphic systems are required.
