## JOB TITLE: Maintenance Mechanic – Carpenter

**BASIC FUNCTION:** Under the supervision of the Facilities Maintenance Manager, performs journey level carpentry in the building and repairs of cabinets and furniture; performs preventive maintenance and routine servicing of equipment to assure efficient operation; understands local, state, and federal building codes.

**PROVIDES WORK OR LEAD DIRECTION TO:** Not applicable – no permanent full-time staff to supervise.

## **REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:**

- 1. Designs, builds, and repairs cabinets and furniture for the Riverside City campus as well as district offices.
- 2. Installs and repairs doors and door hardware.
- 3. Design and build remodel projects including framing, drywall, taping and finish carpentry.
- 4. Performs roof repairs.
- 5. Install and/or replaces floor tiles.
- 6. Performs dry wall repairs; tool repairs; truck bed repairs; and partition repairs.
- 7. Concrete framing and finishing.
- 8. Assists with other maintenance projects related to electrical, mechanical, and plumbing as requested.
- 9. Installs wall coverings.
- 10. Builds and repairs counter tops.
- 11. Assists with graduation set ups.
- 12. Participates in District-provided in-service training programs.
- 13. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty and the public.
- 14. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from high school or GED equivalent is required.

**EXPERIENCE:** One year of skilled or journeyman experience in carpentry, together with building construction and maintenance work, is required. Mechanical ability is required.

**LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS:** Must have a valid California driver's license, and have (and maintain) an insurable driving record acceptable to the District's insurance carrier, is required.

**KNOWLEDGE OF:** Tools, equipment, and materials of carpentry. Must have knowledge of building and fire and safety codes.

**ABILITY TO:** Perform manual work and to handle equipment carefully; work from blueprints and rough sketches; understand oral and written instructions; work harmoniously with others.

**OTHER:** Candidate must demonstrate clear evidence of sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability and ethnic background of city college students, staff and the community.

**CONTACTS:** Co-workers, other departmental staff, vendors, suppliers, and faculty.

**PHYSICAL EFFORT:** Requires the ability to exert some physical effort, such as walking, standing and light lifting; dexterity in the use of fingers, limbs and body in the operation of carpentry and maintenance equipment. Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Maintenance and carpentry environment.
