JOB TITLE: Maintenance Mechanic – Painter

BASIC FUNCTION: Under the supervision of the area Manager, performs a variety of skilled duties involved in the preparation and painting of District buildings, facilities and furniture to maintain proper appearance and protection from rust and decay; prepares, paints, installs, informational signs and directional markings.

PROVIDES WORK OR LEAD DIRECTION TO: Not applicable – no permanent full-time staff to supervise.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

- 1. Responsible for maintaining Riverside City College as well as District Offices as it relates to but not yet limited to the building maintenance painting trade.
- 2. Maintains records for Air Quality Management District of all coatings applied at the Riverside City College as well as District Offices.
- 3. Assists with other maintenance projects related to carpentry, electrical and plumbing as requested.
- 4. Maintaining material safety data sheets (MSDS) for all coatings applied.
- 5. Knowledgeable in methods in removal of graffiti markings on various surfaces at the Riverside City College as well as District Offices.
- 6. Preparation of various surfaces for coatings applications.
- 7. Performs coatings application in compliance with school plant health and safety standards on all District properties.
- 8. Applies high quality low VOC (Volatile Organic Compound) finishes on cabinets and furniture mandated by AQMD.
- 9. Uses HVLP (high volume low pressure) spray gun in spray booth as mandated by AQMD.
- 10. Applied a variety of primers, paints, and other coatings by brush, roller, or airless spray equipment to such surfaces as wood, metal, fiberglass, plaster, wallboard, brick, cement, canvas and all wall coverings.
- 11. Mixes blends and applies protective industrial coatings such as epoxies and marine finishes at the Riverside City College as well as District Offices.
- 12. Mixes blends and applies coatings to match, blend, harmonize, and contrast specified protective and decorative finishes to a variety of surfaces at the Riverside City College as well as District Offices; tests paints and makes recommendations accordingly.
- 13. Applies roof coatings and sealers accordingly to environmental conditions at the Riverside City College as well as District Offices.
- 14. Refinishes gymnasium floors.
- 15. Sigh maker (directional and identifying) for on an off campus sights at the Riverside City College as well as District Offices; made from metal or wood.
- 16. Operates and maintains airless spray equipment, compressed air machines, sandblasting equipment and power washers.

- 17. Erects rigs and scaffolding, boom lifts, and scissor lifts.
- 18. Move furniture, cabinets and other furnishings as necessary to perform required duties.
- 19. Inspects building at the Riverside City College as well as District Offices and other structures to determine painting needs and develops scheduling for completion; also estimates costs of materials, supplies and labor before proceeding with projects.
- 20. Maintains records of coatings applied for future reference.
- 21. Obtains information pertaining to new materials, methods and equipment used in the painting trade.
- 22. Participates in district-provided in-service training programs.
- 23. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty, and the public.
- 24. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.

LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS: Completion of a designated painting apprenticeship. Must have an insurable driver's license.

KNOWLEDGE OF: Local, State and Federal AQMD standards as they relate to the painting trade. Knowledge of methods, materials and equipment used in the glazing and painting trade; basic qualities of various paints and sealers used for school plant purposes and their adaptability and uses in specific situations.

ABILITY TO: Ability to mix and match paints and to blend, harmonize and contrast colors; apply paints by brush, roller or spray gun; use and care for glazing and painting tools; prepare and work from ladders and scaffolds; follow oral and written instructions, work cooperatively with others.

OTHER: Candidate must demonstrate clear evidence of sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability and ethnic background of city college students, staff and the community.

CONTACTS: Co-workers, other departmental personnel, vendors, and suppliers.

PHYSICAL EFFORT: Requires the ability to exert some physical effort, such as walking, standing and light lifting; dexterity in the use of fingers, limbs and body in the operation of maintenance equipment. Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Maintenance environment.
