## **RIVERSIDE CITY COLLEGE DISTRICT CLASSIFIED POSITION DESCRIPTION**

**JOB TITLE:** Maintenance Mechanic – Plumber/Boiler Mechanic

**BASIC FUNCTION:** Under the supervision of the Facilities Maintenance Manager, performs journeyman level boiler repair and performs at a journeyman level in installing maintaining and repairing plumbing fixtures, including gas, water, wastewater, irrigation and related systems.

**PROVIDES WORK OR LEAD DIRECTION TO:** Not applicable – no permanent full-time staff to supervise.

## **REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:**

- 1. Maintains and repairs Riverside City Campus as well as District Office boilers, heating systems and plumbing systems.
- 2. Maintains and repairs all controllers, thermostats, safety devices such as T & P valves, low water cutoff, gas regulator
- 3. Diagnose and troubleshoot relay switches, contact switches, electric motors, pump, mother boards for boiler.
- 4. Assist in HVAC, electrical, carpentry, painting
- 5. Working and practical knowledge of specialized water system such as distilled, reverse osmosis, as well as other filtrations system.
- 6. Working and practical knowledge of specialized waste system, grease interceptors, chemical waste systems.
- 7. Plan estimate, design and install plumbing systems and repair existing systems, including water, gas, air, wastewater, irrigation, backflow and cross-connection prevention; install, maintain and repair various types of het exchange vessels and related systems.
- 8. Install new plumbing fixtures, sinks, basins, toilets, drinking fountains, water heaters, dishwashers and other items.
- 9. Installs water piping, tap water and sewer mains and laterals.
- 10. Prepares and maintains records and reports related to assigned activities, including estimates, hazardous materials records, call logs and equipment and materials receipts.
- 11. Cuts and threads pipes; packs faucets and repairs water supply, waste, sewage and drainage pipes; wipe and wash joints and cleans drains and obstructions.
- 12. Works from blueprints and sketches in the repair of plumbing system; develop rough sketches and isometrics as necessary; develops plot charts of current plumbing facilities.
- 13. Plans, organizes and lays out assigned tasks; estimates labor and materials needed for projects; makes recommendations for the selection, ordering and storage of plumbing supplies and equipment.
- 14. Operates a variety or maintenance-related hand tools and power equipment, including pipe threading and bending equipment, soldering equipment and various gauges, pumps and drain cleaning equipment; operates assigned vehicles including a forklift and front-end loader.
- 15. Communicates with administrators, contractors and other related to assigned projects; trains and provides work direction to maintenance staff as assigned.
- 16. Performs preventive maintenance on fire sprinkler systems and pool equipment.
- 17. Reviews the work of contractors and reports progress
- 18. Installs, repairs, and maintains sump pumps.

- 19. Participates in district-provided in-service training programs.
- 20. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty and the public.
- 21. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.

EDUCATION: Graduation from high school or GED equivalent is required.

**EXPERIENCE:** One year of skilled or journeyman experience in a specialized field, together with building construction and maintenance work, is required. Mechanical ability is required.

LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS: Certified in boiler repair.

**KNOWLEDGE OF:** All plumbing and heating systems, boiler controls and boiler repair.

**ABILITY TO:** Read and design plumbing systems from blueprints

**OTHER:** Candidate must demonstrate clear evidence of sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability and ethnic background of city college students, staff and the community.

**CONTACTS:** Co-workers, other departmental staff and the general public.

**PHYSICAL EFFORT:** Requires the ability to exert some physical effort, such as walking, standing and climbing ladders. Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Maintenance environment.
