- 3. Maintains regular on-site service and repair of equipment for Norco and Moreno Valley campuses.
- 4. Provides information on equipment needs, assists in project estimates, and reports status of equipment under repairs.
- 5. Maintains inventory of repair parts and orders replacement parts as needed.
- 6. Does spot plastering, welding, and sheet metal work.
- 7. Uses a variety of hand and shop tools and equipment.
- 8. May supervise maintenance helpers.
- 9. Maintains files and records related to the operation of the office.
- 10. Participates in District-provided in-service training programs.
- 11. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty, and the public.
- 12. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.
