**BASIC FUNCTION:** Under the supervision of the area Director, responsible for the technical development and production of Performance Riverside shows and events; maintenance of the Performance Riverside website; and assisting the Theater Production Coordinator in design and implementation of theatrical elements; maintaining the shop and other backstage work areas.

## **REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:**

- 1. Designs and constructs Performance Riverside theatrical elements, e.g., scenic designs and lighting for productions, projects, and special events.
- 2. Assists Production Coordinator in all areas of construction in shop; hanging, focusing, and operating theatrical lighting equipment; rigging and fly-mastering; painting and set decoration, and implementing special effects.
- 3. Designs all elements of Performance Riverside's website: www.PerformanceRiverside.org
- 4. Maintains all elements of Performance Riverside's website.
- 5. Serves as Technical Director for Performance Riverside productions per the assignment of the Producing Artistic Director.
- 6. Researches, recommends and gathers bids in purchasing decisions for stage equipment.
- 7. Assists scenic designer/director with development of lighting design for Performance Riverside productions, including redesign of rented scenery or redesign of light plot to accommodate the limitations of the Landis Performing Arts Center.
- 8. Performs general electrical maintenance for all stage lighting and special effects equipment.
- 9. Maintains organization of storage for stage equipment, tools, and scenery.
- 10. Maintains a friendly and professional atmosphere for students, faculty, staff, contractors, and the public who interact with Performance Riverside.
- 11. Participates in District-provided in-service training programs.
- 12. Maintains a friendly, supportive atmosphere for students, staff, faculty, and the public.
- 13. Performs other duties, related to the position, as assigned.

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from high school or GED equivalent.

**EXPERIENCE:** A minimum of four years of increasingly responsible experience as a theatrical technician is required. Two years of experience as a web designer and two years experience as a webmaster are desired.

**KNOWLEDGE OF:** Theatrical blueprints, current scenic construction standards, lighting and sound, are required; PHP and MySQL are preferred.
