

BP 1010 BOARD MEMBERSHIP

Education Code Sections 72023, 72103, and 72104;

The Board of Trustees shall consist of five members elected by the qualified voters of the District. Members shall be elected by trustee area as defined in BP 1100 Board Elections.

The Board of Trustees is charged with the governance of the Riverside Community College District and holds the Chancellor of the District responsible for the administration and management of the District.

Any person who meets the criteria contained in law is eligible to be elected or appointed a member of the Board of Trustees.

An employee of the District may not be sworn into office as an elected or appointed member of the Board of Trustees unless such person resigns as an employee.

No member of the Board of Trustees shall, during the term for which such trustee is elected, hold an incompatible office.

No member of the Board of Trustees shall, during the term for which such member was elected, be eligible to serve on the governing board of a high school district or unified school district whose boundaries are coterminous with those of the community college district.
